Of all the young women in the world at the time, God chose Mary to be the mother of Jesus. The angel informed her that she was "highly favoured" of God (Luke 1:28).

As Rachel, let mothers train children to avoid the strong temptations of the teen years (Genesis 39).

As Jochabed, let mothers train children to love and serve God above the world's riches (Exodus 6:20; 2:1-10).

As Hannah, let mothers teach children to pray (1 Samuel 1:11, 19-28).

As the Shunammite woman, let mothers teach their children to be at peace (2 Kings 4:26).

As Elisabeth, let mothers teach children to be righteous before God (Luke 1:6).

As Mary, let mothers teach children to obey God (Luke 2:51; John 2).

As the Canaanite woman, let mothers cry to Jesus that He might help their daughters (Matthew 15:21-28).

As Mary, John Mark's mother, let mothers teach children to value worship assemblies (Acts 12:12; 2 Timothy 4:11).

As Lois and Eunice, let mothers teach the value of unpretended faith (2 Timothy 1:5).




There is a nursery at the rear of the auditorium up the stairs for infant care.
