The British Army Tank Mk. I was the first British tank to be used in combat during the First World War. It was a heavy tank, designed to break through enemy lines. It was used in the Battle of Cambrai in 1917, where it was the first tank to be used in a large-scale offensive. The tank was a slow-moving, heavy vehicle, but it was a significant development in military technology.

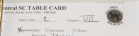

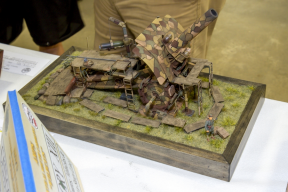

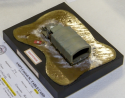
