Criminal & Sex Offender Registry Check on Volunteers/Parent Volunteers

The Hartford, our school insurer, is requiring a policy and procedure to be in place for checking on volunteer's criminal and sex offender status.

Policy: Triumphant Learning Center is a safe haven for students. Adults with a sex offender status or significant criminal background would not be allowed on campus, or in a classroom. They would not be allowed to drive or participate in school sanctioned activities due to their status.

The safety of our students and staff is paramount to creating a safe learning environment:

- Volunteers are be required to submit to a criminal and sex offender background check as based on State Law and/or Insurance Co. policy. The volunteer will be asked to pay 50% of the charges for this background check.
- Alternative to this screening, you may provide a copy of an Arizona Level 1 IVP fingerprint clearance card, law enforcement credentials, correctional officer credentials, or probation officer credentials.

Procedure:

- 1. Use the link provided to log in to Sterling Volunteers https://www.sterlingvolunteers.com/
- 2. Set up an account
- 3. Complete the forms
- 4. Pay your portion
- 5. You will be notified of your clearance and ability to volunteer at the school.

If you go to the Sterling Volunteers website you will need a good deed code number. This number is **fhmgi5L**
