The **Republican** Party began at a protest meeting in Ripon, Wisconsin, on 28 February 1854 as a group of antislavery activists, known as Free Soilers, met to start a new grassroots movement. The first party convention took place in Jackson, Michigan, that same year on 6 July.
















The elephant symbol associated with the **Republican party** was created by cartoonist Thomas Nast in 1874.
