Shows last about 2 hours and consist of: Jazz, Modern, Contemporary, Tap, Alumni, Company, Pointe, brief intermission and the main ballet, **Alice in Wonderland**, which is all Beginner through Advanced Ballet Classes

NOTES

Casting: Unfortunately, there is no way to keep siblings together for the main ballet. There are too many siblings, as well as jazz, tap and ballet combinations. Parents of any dancers who do not have their tap or jazz and ballet in the same show should speak with the desk staff for special information.

Rehearsals:

- Regular classes for Beginner 1&2 through Advanced Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary, Modern and Tap finish on Saturday, May 2, 2020.
- The week of May 4 – May 9 rehearsals will be held at **Dance for Joy** for Beginner 1&2 through Advanced Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary, Modern and Tap classes.
- The week of May 11, 2020, there are no classes at **Dance for Joy**; all students will have rehearsals **at Yorktown Stage 1974 Commerce St. Yorktown Heights, NY 10598.**
- A REHEARSAL SCHEDULE WILL BE HANDED OUT AS SOON AS IT IS FINALIZED.

Please note: Our scheduled year ends with the performance of Spring Recital 2020!

Conflicts:

- Conflicts with rehearsal times are inevitable.
- If your dancer must miss, they should check with classmates to find out what they missed.

Costumes/Hair:

- For all ballet classes: light pink **FOOTED** tights, with NO seams (convertible tights for Int 1-Adv), and pink or white ballet slippers with elastics securely sewn. (Boys see teacher for specifics.)
- Dancers in jazz and in Int. 1 through Advanced must wear a nude camisole leotard underneath to allow for changing.
- NO UNDERWEAR OR BRAS UNDER COSTUMES!
- NO JEWELRY, ACCESSORIES, OR NAIL POLISH PLEASE! Small earrings (studs) are fine!
- Hair must be neatly pulled into a secure bun at the crown of the head and light makeup applied at home.
- For pointe: You must buy a specific leotard and skirt for pointe; Ms. Dancewear has them in stock:
 - Capezio leotard CC100, Mirella S12 for the skirt
 - Int 1: White
 - Int 2/4: Navy
 - IA: Maroon
 - Adv: Black
- Additional recital wear (ie. tights) for jazz, contemporary and modern will be announced if necessary.
- Costumes will be handed out as they come in and each class has earned enough gold stars. (Good conduct in class!)
- Costumes will only be handed out when tuition is paid in full.

Video: We will be having a professional video taken of the shows by Montas Studio. Order forms will be posted on our website soon.

- All seating is reserved - anyone using a seat must have a ticket.
- Small children who will sit on your lap do not need a ticket. If they take up a seat, they will need a ticket.
