### **EQUITATION DIVISIONS & CLASSES**

**Leadline** - Riders 7 yrs and under. May cross enter into Walk-Trot. **Walk-Trot** - Open to riders 10 and under. May cross enter into any WT class. **Short Stirrup Equitation** - Riders 11 yrs and under. Judged on the rider. To show over crossrails.

**Beginner Rider Equitation** - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing. Judged on the rider. May cross enter Pleasure, Low/Pre-Children's or Low/Pre Adult Amateur. To show over crossrails.

**Junior Equitation** - Open to junior riders only. Judged on rider. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses.

#### Brass Ring@Devon Medal Class (Qualifier)

Open to all junior riders, two simple tests included in the first round over fences. Ponies 2', Horses 2'6". Top six riders will be automatically qualified for our Medal Finals to be run at the Brass Ring@Devon Horse Show on July 15th, 2019.

#### **HUNTER DIVISIONS**

**Short Stirrup Hunter** - Riders 11 yrs and under. Judged on mount. To show over simple verticals 18".

**Low/Pre-Children's Pony Hunter** - Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. All ponies jump 2'. May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter.

**Low/Pre-Children's Hunter Horse** - Open to Junior riders on horses. Judged on mount. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Children's Hunter. **Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to

jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

**Children's Hunter -** Open to junior riders. Judged on mount. May not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter. Horses 3', Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'.

**Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'9". May not cross enter into Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter **Baby Green Hunter** - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Open to all riders. Judged on mount. Ponies all to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting on corners not to be penalized.

**Thoroughbred Hunter** - Open to any Thoroughbreds, all riders. Judged on mount. To jump 2'3".

**Developing Hunter** - Open to all. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. Judged on mount. To jump under 18" crossrails or small verticals.

#### PLEASURE DIVISIONS

**Pleasure Pony -** Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. Walk Trot, Walk-Trot-Canter, and to jump 18"-2'.

**Pleasure Horse** - Open to all riders on horses. Judged on mount. Walk-Trot, Walk-Trot-Canter. Horses to jump 2'6".

#### WINNER'S INVITATIONAL CHALLENGE

Open to horses and ponies winning a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place ribbon over fences in a hunter division. These horses and ponies will be eligible to show in an additional Winner's Challenge Class. To be judged on the mount. Will be run at the conclusion of the division at the respective height.
