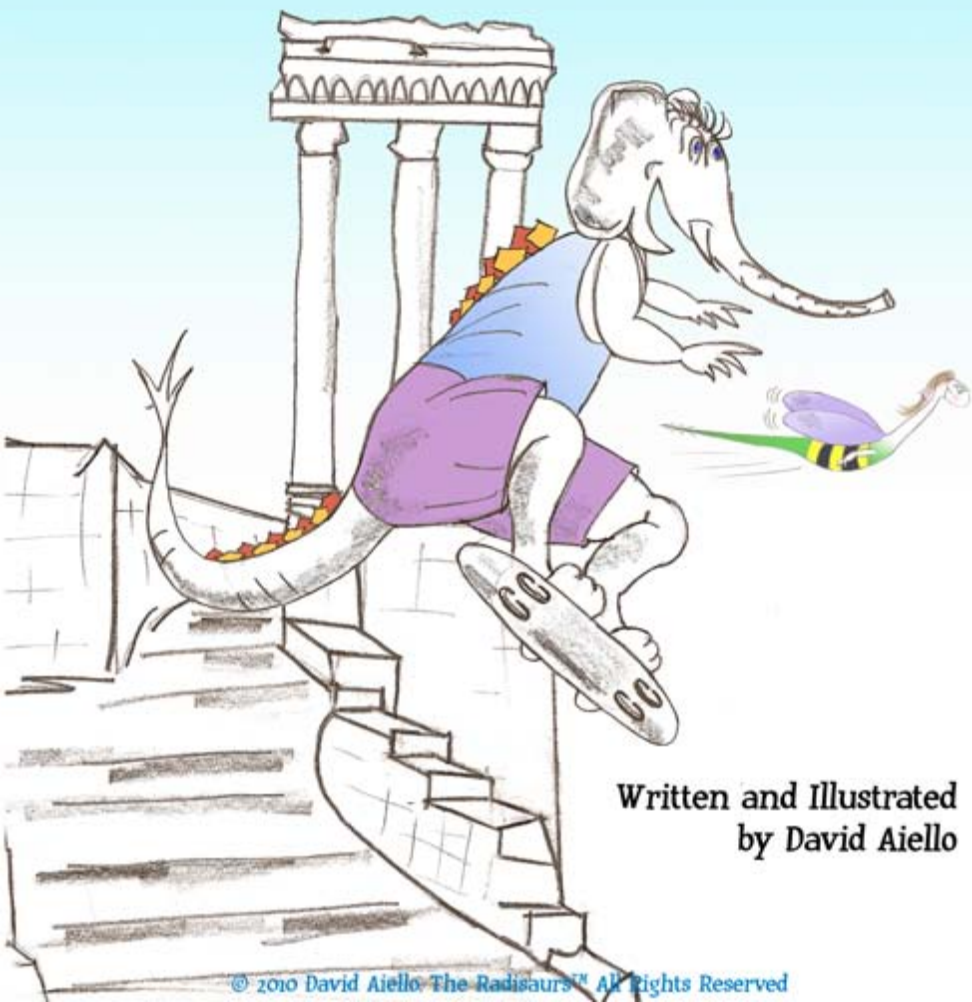


The Radisaurs
