Guidelines for the 2021 OVS Competition

Recordings due: Sunday, April 4, 2021

Prizes will be awarded in three categories:

Division I: Grade school and middle school through age 14; \$100/\$50

Division II: High school through age 18; \$200/\$100

Division III: College undergraduate through age 23; \$500/\$250/\$100 *Violists who have previously won first prize in their division are eligible to enter the division of the next age group.*

Non-refundable application fee:

Division I \$20

Division II \$20

Division III \$25

Deadline for application and fee is April 4, 2021.

Repertoire requirements:

All works must be performed from memory. All music must be recorded without piano.

Division I (5-10 minutes)

-Two contrasting solo pieces or movements

Division II (10-15 minutes)

- -Two movement from an unaccompanied suite, sonata or partita by J.S. Bach
- -One movement from an unaccompanied work by a composer other than J.S. Bach. A special prize will be awarded for performance of an unaccompanied work by a Black, Indigenous, or People of Color composer. For a list of suggestions:

Division III (10-15 minutes)

- -Two movements from a solo suite, sonata or partita by J.S. Bach
- -One movement from an unaccompanied work by a composer other than J.S. Bach. A special prize will be awarded for performance of an unaccompanied work by a Black, Indigenous, or People of Color composer.
