The Garden and Beautification Committee had their regular meeting on March. 6, 2014 at the **Clubhouse with 20+ members present.** 

This has been a busy month. 106 residents enjoyed the Dinner Dance based on the exit surveys they returned. Thanks to the 30+ gardeners who volunteered to plan, sell tickets, cook, bake, secure door prizes and gifts for the raffle, staff the kitchen and clean. They raised a good amount toward Gardens beautification projects.

We had more than 20 turn out for our workday on February 13 to complete some of the necessary gardening tasks including cleaning around and fertilizing the trees along Englewood Road and at the entry to the Clubhouse drive along with several other jobs.

I failed to mention in our February report that Fred Streif replaced the rotten wood and repaired the announcement sign in front of the Rec Center. GGC staff then painted the sign.

The shrubs have been installed around the entry sign at Coliseum and Englewood Road. The palm fans there were transplanted to the Gene Borseth memory bench at the turn in to the Rec Center. Thanks to the Association for helping with the completion of this project and to the Gardeners for funding the transplanting of the palms.

On March 1, the much anticipated memory plaza was installed around the memory benches by the pond at the Clubhouse. The Gardeners have been planning this and raising the funds for it for more than a year now. If you haven't ventured there since that date, take time to do so. It is lovely. We especially want to thank gardeners John Dezinzo and Fred Streif for the hard work they did toward planning the project and securing the company to do this. While all the price details are not yet worked out for the second phase of this project, the plaza bricks can be replaced and engraved as people wish to create memories or honor those who have lived in the Gardens. We will publish the full details when they are finalized.

On March 8, twenty Garden residents joined in the Great American Cleanup and picked up 21 large bags of trash around the Gardens. Thanks to gardener Carolyn Strief for being the coordinator with Charlotte County this year and to all the residents and gardeners who participated.



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
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
