Your pet's safety and comfort are very important to us here at Western Veterinary Clinic. To help ensure their health, all pets having surgery here must be examined by one of our doctors. If we have examined them within the past year, the pre-surgical examination will be performed at no charge.

Several services that we provide to further enhance your pet's safety are detailed below. These services have an additional cost which is listed.

Pre-Anesthetic Blood Screening:

Basic (\$45.31): Evaluates those organ systems most directly affecting the safety of anesthesia (the liver and kidneys) and tests for anemia and dehydration. This testing can help us plan the anesthetic procedures that are the best for your pet. Recommended for animals greater than 5 years of age or with other health concerns.

Comprehensive (\$65.52): For mature patients, over 10 years old, we highly recommend a more extensive screening. This will provide a more diagnostic health check which provides valuable information for both anesthetic safety and future health care.

Post-Operative Pain Management:

We offer pain management medication following surgery. Our pets feel pain just as we do, even though they may not show it. If you choose pain management and your pet is under 5 years we also **RECOMMEND** basic blood screening; if your pet is over 5 years we **REQUIRE** basic blood screening. We understand this adds an additional cost, but it is to ensure that your pet is safe to receive these medications. Cost of pain management varies based on species and procedure.

Microchip Placement (\$69.27): We highly recommend the Home Again Microchip. This is an advanced pet identification and recovery system. It is a service that can be done anytime. Your pet does not need to be anesthetized, but an elective anesthetic procedure is a convenient time to do this. We see the importance of identification of lost or injured pets daily, so we take every opportunity to discuss this matter with our client. This includes one year membership to Home Again, after that year you may renew your membership for an additional fee to Home Again. If you choose not to renew this membership the microchip is still registered with Home Again and Western Veterinary Clinic.

I understand that this does not relieve me of responsibility of all costs incurred for services and boarding.
