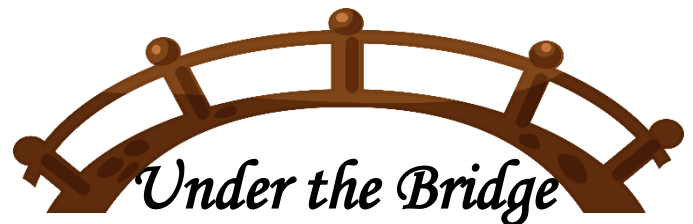
Please send us your recommendations for Baronial Awards. Include mundane and SCA (if they have one), the award recommended and the reason you feel the gentle should receive award.
