I thank You, Sir, for Your promised Holy Spirit that guides, directs, teaches, and reminds me of things You have spoken to/for me. Holy Spirit, I trust that You have touched the hearts prepared to receive Your Word. Help each of us to NOT become bewildered by the world around us, but instead, to draw closer to You through Your Word. In Jesus name I pray and believe, AMEN."

As we begin here, let me preface again, "I am NOT against the vaccine! However, what I am against is a MANDATED vaccine." I personally believe that, like a flu shot, each individual has the right to accept or refuse it. AND, I'm NOT saying that I will NEVER take this shot. While testing shows that my antibodies are as strong and as increasing as someone that has had the shot, why would I need to partake of it? I personally have known many people who 'have been' vaccinated and still contracted COVID. In fact, the science even shows, even if you are vaccinated you can still be a carrier. If 'you' feel the need to take this vaccine, then by all means TAKE IT! I was not testing my faith nor was God testing my faith. Regardless, we STILL stand on and believe, our God is a good God! He did NOT manufacture this virus AND neither is He inflicting it on people to test their faith! ALL of this is the work of the enemy! By this I mean, our enemy has no way of inflicting his will and plans in this world without the help of 'people'. When the devil has the use of a person's mind and will, it's only then that he can inflict his will upon the earth, through these willing vessels. With this said, I am NOT alluding to 'someone who was found to be a carrier as being used by the devil.' Keep all of this in context and DON'T allow the enemy to twist these words in your head.

Look here what 1 Peter 5:8 (AMPC) states, "Be well balanced (temperate, sober of mind), be vigilant and cautious at all times; for that enemy of yours, the devil, roams around like a lion roaring [in fierce hunger], seeking someone to seize upon and devour." I believe this Scripture to confirm the statement I just made above. But I also believe the antidote to Verse 8 is Verse 7, "Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully."

Before I move on, Jesus assures us in John 10:10, "The thief, the liar, the devil, is ALWAYS attempting to destroy the family unit. Why? Because he knows that 'family' is God's plan and family has strength in unity. And just because a family has different views on certain topics shouldn't mean that we allow the enemy to divide and separate the family unit. If you will notice, Jesus promises us that the thief WILL come to steal, kill, and destroy. But don't stop there. He goes on to assure us that when we believe and trust in Him, He offers us lives not without attacks, but lives 'in Him' to the fullest! Let me assure you, EVEN in our differences, and it's trying sometimes, but our immediate family believes, trusts, and stands on the firm foundation of the promises of God! Someone say, "AMEN!!"

Let's see if I can bring this back around to finish these messages, hopefully with a better understanding of 'our' purpose in all that is going on in this world of fear we are in today.

We will start here with Paul in 2 Timothy 2:1-5 (NLT), as he gives us ALL great instruction and especially in these days of such confusion. "Timothy, my dear son, be strong through the grace that God gives you in Christ Jesus. You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others. Endure suffering along with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. Soldiers don't get tied up in the affairs of civilian life, for then they cannot please the officer who enlisted them. And athletes cannot win the prize unless they follow the rules." Paul didn't tell Timothy just to be strong. No! He told him to "be strong through the grace that God gives you IN CHRIST JESUS." Neither can any of us "fight the good fight of faith" in our own strength!

In 1 Timothy 6:12 (NLT), Paul encourages his spiritual son Timothy, and us as well, "Fight the good fight for the true faith. Hold tightly to the eternal life to which God has called you, which you have declared so well before many witnesses." Fighting the good fight of faith means that we abide in the Word by faith, regardless of what we feel or what we think we understand. To fight the good fight of faith also means that we stand firmly anchored in the Word, in the power of the Spirit, reckoning ourselves dead to our feelings and our human reasoning, not letting sin rule in our mortal body by obeying its lusts. Jesus said, "If you hold to My tracking, you are really My disaglates. Then you will know the truth,

and the truth will set you tree. (John 8:31 NIV). Jesus is communicating to us that it is His Word that is truth, NOT the understanding and word of the world we now live in.

Here, in Romans 12:13–21 (Passion Translation), we see some very important instruction of how to live free in this world today while glorifying God. "Take a constant interest in the needs of God's beloved people and respond by helping them. And eagerly welcome people as guests into your home. Speak blessing, not cursing, over those who reject and persecute you. Celebrate with those who celebrate, and weep with those who grieve. Live happily together in a spirit of harmony and be as mindful of another's worth as you are your own. Don't live with a lofty mind-set, thinking you are too important to serve others, but be willing to do menial tasks and identify with those who are humble minded. Don't be smug or even think for a moment that you know it all. Never hold a grudge or try to get even but plan your life around the noblest way to benefit others. Do your best to live as everybody's friend. Beloved, don't be obsessed with taking revenge, but leave that to God's righteous justice. For the Scriptures say, 'Vengeance is mine, and I will repay,' says the Lord. And: If your enemy is hungry, buy him lunch! Win him over with kindness. For your surprising generosity will awaken his conscience, and God will reward you with favor. Never let evil defeat you, but defeat evil with good." We all have passions and desires that push us to believe the opposite. Our human reasoning tries to persuade us that, "This is impossible; if I follow this, they will believe they can do what they want with me; they will try to walk all over me!" But remember, God's Word is truth and many times our perception is misguided.

Paul goes on to tell us, in 1 Corinthians 9:23-25, why we run and fight this good fight of faith, "I do everything to spread the Good News and share in its blessings. Don't you realize that in a race everyone runs, but only one person gets the prize? So run to win! All athletes are disciplined in their training. They do it to win a prize that will fade away, BUT we do it for an eternal prize." I'm sure you all remember where I wrote that watching the news or even just reading the 'over the freeway signs', to put it mildly, were truly ruffling my feathers. Well, as I began to overcome the enemy's attack in my understanding of the Word again, the Holy Spirit directed me to these verses in 2 Timothy 2:1-5. More specifically, in 2 Timothy 2:3-4, He told me, "Endure suffering along with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. Soldiers don't get tied up in the affairs of civilian life, for then they cannot please the officer who enlisted them." I knew right then that most of the confusion I had been experiencing was because I was more focused with what was going on in the world than what I knew God had instructed me personally to do. Almost immediately I repented for allowing myself to get caught up in ALL that the world was saying and doing. The foundational message that God gave me, over 14 years ago, was to "Share hope, love and encouragement with those who have lost sight of these three things." Right then I saw that I had had one foot in the stirrup and one foot on the ground instead of fully seated 'in' the saddle of His direction.

In all of the previous years to this last experience I have done my best, with the Holy Spirit's help, to share with all of you the hope, love and encouragement that comes from having God and His Word, Jesus, in our lives. In what felt like my weakest point since 'our' beginning the enemy attempted to take advantage of that weakness as an opportunity to wail on me. But let me assure you all, no matter how weak we may feel, when we continue to renew our minds with the Word of God and allow His Word to be written on our hearts, we will ALWAYS prevail!

Let's all agree, right now, to close off our minds to the world's secular noises and its understanding while we meditate on these next Scriptures. "For through the eternal and living Word of God you have been born again. And this "seed" that He planted within you can never be destroyed but will live and grow inside of you forever. For: Human beings are frail and temporary, like grass, and the glory of man fleeting like blossoms of the field. The grass dries and withers and the flowers fall off, but the Word of the Lord endures forever!" (1 Peter 1:23-25 TPT)

Jesus Himself assures us, "I tall you the truth, this generation will not pass from the seams until all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but thy words will never pass away," (Matthew 24:34-35) My original intent in using these two verses was to show that, heaven and earth will pass away, but His words will NEVER pass away. Then as I was rereading verse 34, I was redirected by the Holy Spirit to go back and reference, "I tall you the truth, this generation will NOT pass from the seams until all these things take place." In order to find out what things Jesus was speaking about I had to go back and reread the previous Scriptures. I also encourage all of you to go back and read Matthew 24:1-33. Even though some of what is going on in the world today may have a resemblance to what Jesus is saying here, not all of it is visible. And Jesus clearly said, "until ALL these things take place." However, I believe the things going on in the world around us DO indicate we ARE in those days. Rereading these Scriptures we should be gaining an even stronger urgency to share the Good News of Jesus with all those who don't yet know Him!

The prophet Isaiah heard this from the LORD, "'Shout!' I asked, 'What should I shout?' 'Shout that people are like the grass. Their beauty fades as quickly as the flowers in a field. The grass withers and the flowers fade beneath

Then I realized I'm not addicted, I am a child of the Most High God, I have victory because of the finished work of Jesus' shed blood. We have victory, we have to claim it. We need to dry out, pray up and realize we entertain thoughts, then we choose to use. After the first use, we think more about it, then use again. Then it gets worse and worse, then we get stuck. But it all starts by a thought and a choice. So, live on purpose, not everything we do we have a choice, and we have a way out and we have victory in our failure though we may fall.

God loves us and will show you and teach you and give you strength to say no. It is not an accident that you are where you are, living by who you are living by. Glory and Honor By J.L.

I wanted to reach out with something that really matters to me and is one of those things definitely worth sharing because, first, it gives our Father glory to know His children love Him, are receiving and understanding more the ways He wants for us – called, His will.

In the October issue of the Overcomers for Official you placed some words I had written to 'Duck', about tithe/giving and I must say, I felt touched by that but more so than that, my Heavenly Father did AND my earthly father will also because I'm going to send my copy to him.

In Matthew 7:17-18, "A good tree produces good truit, and a bad tree produces bad truit. A good tree early produce bad truit, and a bad tree produces good truit?" we learn about, from Jesus, how a tree is identified by its fruit. Pretty plainly Jesus says that whatever is in our hearts, is what we express and speak. The seeds planted in a Christians life are generally by a praying grandparent, a dedicated mom or dad, a friend, etc. ... and Jesus is the water that brings life to the branches and nurtures us to bring forth fruit.

Continuing on in *Matthew 7:18-19*, Jesus explains, "So every tree that does not produce good truft is chopped down and thrown into the true. Yes, just as you can identify a tree by its truft, so you can identify people by their actions," The closer we are to Jesus Christ the sweeter and healthier our fruit becomes. When we stay clear of Jesus and don't develop a desire to honor and please the Father with our purpose, to give Him true worship it's then that no fruit is produced whatsoever. Worship comes not only in the form of singing, Scripture reading, prayer, and fellowship but also in our everyday lives. We are to do everything as unto the Lord, work, school or whatever we do.

Jesus further explains, in John 15:1-5, "I am the true grapevine, and My Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch of Mine that doesn't produce truft, and He prunes the branches that do bear truft so they will produce even more. You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. Remain in Me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce truft if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be truftful unless you remain in Me. Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much truft. For spart from Me you can do nothing." Then notice the promise Jesus gave us, in John 15:7, "But if you remain in Me and My words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!" Quite simply, when no fruit is being produced in our lives 'we' have separated ourselves from the Vine and are just walking around taking up space. At that point we are empty, and our life is considered a spiritually dead life, sort of like Adam and Eve.

So, my dad adopted me at 1 month old and shortly after he gave his life to Jesus and became saved. He says, "It's God's providence and it was then that the seed took to the water." Like the Israelites, it took way longer for me and actually the same time it took them, 40 years. I thank God He is patient. On my own I too had to seek God and it's been a long, long process, one that's landed me in prison several times. Regardless, I've carried with me what things I was taught as a child, Bible Scriptures, lessons taught to me by a Sunday school teacher or by my dad. Stuff like, happiness is based on happenings, but true peace is better to attain because no matter what things look like, no matter the losses or hard spots – peace surpasses it all and remains within, untouched. I was also taught that my availability is worth far more than my ability.

My dad also taught us how to tithe, the importance and the value in the obedient act of tithing. Now that I am 49 years old, it's a blessing to see the fruits of the seeds planted by people who loved me enough to do so come to fruition. This is why I'm sending my October issue of the Outcomers for Official newsletter to my dad. It's a privilege and an honor to do so because my dad never gave up on me. His legacy has carried over and now it's my honor to do so to others. I've heard it said, and now understand, "God has no grandchildren." Which means none of us go to heaven because our parents or grandparents were Christians. Each of us has to develop and nurture our own relationship with God through giving our lives to Jesus. Now my dad can know, "He did good" like he tells others when they do something of value.

It's our Father in heaven who I give glory to because He is so loving to His children, and as I've already said "patient".

Confronting Wrong By Stephen Arterburn

"Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted." - Galatians 6:1

God has given us the responsibility to honestly confront those who do wrong. For most of us, confrontation is a difficult task. For a few, it's much too easy. I hope you don't delight in finding fault in others. If you do, stop, and consider if you do this as a way of overlooking your own faults.

God does call you, however, to help others see the truth. In essence, you can hold up a mirror to your good friends, and they hopefully will do the same for you.

Jude, the brother of Jesus, reminds us that we are to deal honestly and directly with those who do wrong, while showing them mercy (*Jude 22-23*). Help others see their faults but with great humility. You're not responsible for the behavior of others, but you are responsible to gently and tactfully point out areas of misbehavior that may cause them to stumble, fall, or lose their way.

Are you avoiding some tough conversations? If you have kids, are you confronting them? And when you do, are you doing it with gentleness and humility? Check yourself. Is your tone respectful? Is your word choice uplifting or condescending? God calls you to show courage by addressing wrong. But remember the goal is always to see the other person restored, not belittled. Help that person turn back to God.

"These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world." - John 16:33
