## **SELF-AUTHENTICATING**

"To say that Scripture is self-authenticating is to assert that it possesses an inherent authority, independent of human endorsement, scholarly verification, or external evidence.

Self-authentication means that the Bible is self-attesting. It bears the hallmarks of God's voice-clarity, consistency, moral authority, and spiritual power-that distinguish it from other writings.

Denying the validity, and authenticity of the Bible, does not invalidate the Bible.

To invalidate the Bible as a self-authenticating writing the opposition must "prove" wherein it is corrupt: Fraud.

Can anyone challenge a self-authenticating document?

Yes, while self-authenticating documents are generally accepted as valid, someone can still challenge their authenticity. For example, if (emph. mine, ret), there is evidence that the document was forged or improperly created, it can be disputed in court." LegalBrief AI
