- "Parent Prep: Building Resilience with Families" workshop: Is a 60 to 90 minute workshop designed for parents and guardians to build their capacity to support children's needs before, during and after a crisis or disaster. In addition, it equips parents with basic knowledge and skills to improve their household preparedness. This training will be held in our Little Havana center on April 30th from 5:00 pm-6:30 pm. And in our Miami Beach center on May 7th from 5:00pm-6:30pm. Child care and food will be offered for free to those who attend this wonderful workshop!! A memo went out today along with a sign-up sheet. We look forward for a big turnout for this workshop!!
- *Pre-K Prep Rally: Emergency Preparedness" sessions: These sessions will offer children the opportunity to provide a safe space for individual and group reflection on planning, emergency preparedness, and coping with natural disasters. By promoting the emotional well-being of children, this program supports emergency planning and facilitation in conversations of how to better prepare for emergencies through cooperative play, discussion, creative arts, and literature.
