- I. American Revolution
- 1. Enlightenment ideas sparked the Revolution
- 2. Men had inalienable rights (Can not be surrendered)
- 3. Helped spark the French Revolution
 - II. French Society
 - 1. France made up into 3 estates
 - 2. First Estate: Clergy
 - 3. They owned 10-15% of the land
 - 4. Second Estate: Nobles
 - 5. Highest positions in gov't, church and army
 - 6. Third Estate: Peasants, middle class, bourgeoisie, artisans, and merchants
 - 7. Made up 98% of population

III. Causes of the French Revolution

- 1. 1789 France was Bankrupt
- 2. Could no longer pay their debts
- 3. Clergy, nobles, universities, did not pay taxes
- 4. Third estate paid all the taxes
- 5. Kings: deficit spending
- 6. Low wages
- 7. High prices
- 8. Deficit Spending
- 9. Wars: 7-years War AKA, French and Indian War 1754-1763
- 10. France gave GB Canada and Land East of the Mississippi
- 11. American Revolution also expensive

IV Women

- 1. 1789 could not feed their families
- 2. Marched on Paris
- 3. 6 thousand women took Louis XVI and family hostage
- 4. They did this to help food crisis

V. Storming of the Bastille

- 1. July 14, 1789
- 2. People despised the Bastille
- 3. It was a symbol of beatings and torture
- 4. Peasant's mob surrounded Bastille
- 5. Plan was to steal weapons (cannons, muskets) for protection
- 6. Eventually took control of Bastille
- 7. The Bastille surrenders; the head of the Bastille was killed
- 8. Started the French Revolution
