

### Chief's Chatter cont'd .....


This year we have welcomed a number of new club members and we have 2 more, Ron and Kathy Bosma from Holland and Brian, and Marty Robertson also of Holland.

## **Monthly Meeting Minutes**

#### July 2022 Meeting Report

Our July 5<sup>th</sup> meeting had us gather at DCM (Dodge Central of Michigan) on Chicago Drive in Zeeland, MI. DCM specializes in Dodge pickup trucks from the 1930s to the 1980s, and Plymouth pickup trucks from 1935 to 1941. Father, Steve Flokstra, and son Todd, started the business several years ago when Todd bought an old 1946 Dodge pickup truck. They soon found out there were no sources of new or used parts, so they started buying whole trucks for the parts needed for Todd's truck. Soon, they were buying and selling trucks and parts for others in the hobby with the same interests.

As time went on, they began to reproduce popular parts that were impossible to find. More and more parts were added to their catalog until what you see today. They have a very successful business with a beautiful building (just expanded to include a showroom) to fabricate the reproduction parts, and a shipping department too. Used trucks are stored out back behind the building.

Steve and Todd showed us around to see what they do, and we got to see several trucks they were working on for customers, as well as their shop truck, a 1962(?) Dodge pickup truck that has been pro-toured with a Cummins 4-cylinder diesel, 5-speed manual transmission, Ford 9-inch rear axle, big disc brakes, fancy modern wheels and tires. They left the original patina'd paint alone.

The tour was very impressive, and Steve and Todd were very gracious hosts. Todd even had made Pontiac key fobs on their computer controlled fabricating machine for us! Thank you to the Flokstra family for their hospitality.

After the tour of DCM, most everyone went for ice cream nearby.

We didn't have a business meeting, so the only thing to write about is Linda Walker's Treasurer's Report. We had income from dues and the spring dust off. There were no expenses.

Also, our club roster shows our membership up to 50, the highest it's been in years!
