SUBJECT: Report of significant recommendations during TAAG's Zoom teleconferenced July 15, 2021 Board meeting

TAAG has no new recommendations to the County regarding Templeton area project applications.

TAAG is considering expanding its boundaries beyond the Templeton Unified School District to include small areas of unrepresented residents adjacent to the current boundaries. This will be reviewed in the Community Outreach and Public Relations Committee, and a recommendation will be made to the TAAG Board.

The TAAG Water Committee presented information regarding the proposed Lake Nacimiento water banking plan proposed by the SLO County Shandon-San Juan Water District. The Water Committee recommended that a letter be sent to the State Water Resource Control Board, Division of Water Rights. This letter was unanimously approved with one Delegate recusing himself. A copy of the letter is attached below in an Addendum.

The TAAG Board's consensus is to continue with zoom meetings for now with the plan to transition to hybrid meetings both in-person and on-line when that is available to us, probably sometime in the fall. Committees can choose to do their meetings either in-person or via Zoom.
