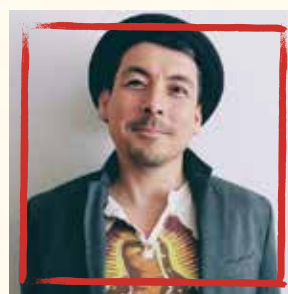

Gustavo Arellano

Gustavo Arellano is the publisher and editor of Orange County's alternative weekly OC Weekly, and the author of the column ¡Ask a Mexican!, which is syndicated nationally. Arellano has won numerous awards for the column,

including the 2006 and 2008 Best Non-Political Column in a large-circulation weekly from the Association of Alternative Newsweeklies, the 2007 Presidents Award from the Los Angeles Press Club and an Impacto Award from the National Hispanic Media Coalition, and a 2008 Latino Spirit award from the California Latino Legislative Caucus.



Steven Alvarez

Dr. Steven Alvarez is an assistant professor of English and Coordinator of the First-Year Writing Program at St. John's University since Spring 2017, and previously taught in the Writing, Rhetoric, and Digital Studies Dept. at

the University of Kentucky. There, he taught "Taco Literacy," a course exploring the foodways of Mexican immigrants in the US South. He's authored *Brokering Tareas: Mexican Immigrant Families Translanguaging Homework Literacies and Community Literacies en Confianza: Learning from Bilingual After-School Programs*. He also has three books of poetry, his latest, *The Codex Mojaodicus*, winner of the 2016 Fence Modern Poets Prize.
