MEDICAL MARIJUANA ZONING AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 201

An Ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Dryden to define and regulate medical marijuana dispensaries.

THE VILLAGE OF DRYDEN ORDAINS:

Dryden Village Zoning Ordinance No. 200 is hereby amended to add a Section 14.18 as follows:

Section 14.18. MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES.

All medical marijuana dispensaries shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. Any medical marijuana dispensary shall be in continual compliance with all state laws pertaining to the growing, possession, use or distribution of medical marijuana and shall be in continual compliance with the Dryden Village Medical Marijuana Ordinance.
2. Medical marijuana dispensaries shall only be allowed to operate in single family dwellings which are occupied as residences. No medical marijuana dispensary shall be allowed to operate in any office building, commercial building, industrial building, apartment building or residential apartment.
3. No more than one (1) caregiver shall operate out of any medical marijuana dispensary location. In no event shall more than one caregiver conduct operations on a single parcel of land.
4. Any medical marijuana dispensary shall be at least one thousand (1,000) feet from any school property line and at least five hundred (500) feet from any church or library building.

Dryden Village Zoning Ordinance No. 200 is hereby further amended to add the following definition:

Section 23.01. *Medical Marijuana Dispensary.* A facility where any primary caregiver grows, cultivates, stores, dispenses or offers medical marijuana for sale to “qualifying patients” under the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act of 2008. The terms “primary caregiver,” “qualifying patient” and “marijuana” shall have the meanings prescribed to them in the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act of 2008.
