# **Supply list for Frog and Pumpkins**

Original by Marlene Kreutz, taught by Linda McDonald

PALETTE DECOART AMERICANA:

Antique Gold, Bright Orange or Pumpkin, Burnt Sienna, Hauser light Green, Hauser Dark Green, Lamp Black, Plum, Moon Yellow, Neutral Grey, Lavender, Dioxazine Purple, Sand, Snow White, Tangerine.

BRUSHES: flats or filberts: #2, #6, #8, #10. Large flat to basecoat. Liner or scroller

MISC: Marlene did this on a Keepsake Box from www.jbwood.com #0978. 81/4x81/4 x 11/4. I've done mine on a 6x6x1 1/2 canvas and a second on a flat 8x8 canvas. If you want a stencil for the STARS Marlene used the Creative Coach Stencil——Falling Stars Background (BCS312). I just painted the stars on.

Basic supplies of paper towels, water container, transfer paper (white) Palette paper, etc.

PREPARATION: Basecoat with Black. Transfer pattern.

March Meeting


Peggy taught her Halloween piece on pavers. Louise filled in until Peggy could get there. 7

DA Americana Paints:


Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Umber, Cad Orange, Cad Yellow, Dioxazine Purple, Hauser Light Green, Lamp Black, Lavender, Light Buttermilk, Med Flesh, Milk Chocolate, Neutral Gray, Orchid, Pumpkin, Slate Gray, Terra Cotta, Tit. White.

If you have NEON: Electric Blue, Torrid Orange, Thermal Green. I didn't use these and you need only a small amount.

Surface of your own choice. Design size is 5" X 12"

Brushes: your favorites PREP: Basecoat in Lamp Black. Trace on design. Under light colors you might want to base with Slate Grey. Hands and Faces: flesh color Shirts & Legs: Lt Buttermilk Hats & right "O": Lavendar Left "O" & Exclamation point: Hauser Light Green Shirts & "B": Pumpkin Shoes: Neutral Grey Moon: Cad Yellow Cart & Wheels: Terra Cotta Hatbands: Hauser Light Green


