There will be a Board meeting starting at 6:30 p.m. – All members are welcome to sit in.

## **Nov. 19 Program: Peer Review**

Our announced presenter Donna Brok has cancelled so our next presentation meeting will be a peer critique session. Please bring 2 digital images on a thumb drive. Please have only those 2 images on the thumb drive to make the process easier for all. We will have a sign-up sheet on the table near the entrance. Keep your thumb drive until your name comes up. At that time, you may give the technician your drive and talk about your pieces. We encourage the audience to first give positive feedback to the images and then suggest changes to improve the image. We hope this will be a helpful, skill-sharing and friendly dialogue. We're looking forward to seeing all of you.

The deadline for submission of images for the digital competition is midnight on the Monday preceding the competition day (Oct. 29<sup>th</sup> this month). The image should be in jpeg format and resized to 1920 in the longest dimension. Please name image files with your name and the title (Your Name – Title of Image.jpg). Note the single space on either side of the dash. Any extraneous information will become part of the title or author. Please also put the month in the subject of the email (Images for Month).

## Camera Rochester Meetup

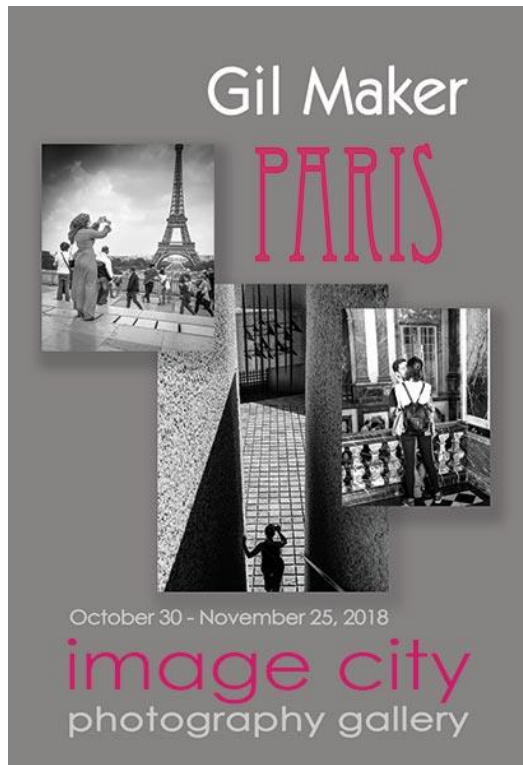
