- Trails should be pretty good shape, other than in-town signs.
- No logging will start on Old Plymouth road this year.
- After CCC is closed going into Plymouth. There is no way to connect to Plymouth. WR80 to WR77. Basically where CCC meets Route 100. Guy closed a small section of trail in Plymouth. This gentleman has a problem with local law enforcement.

- Open discussion about a reroute ideas. Also new signs going up with advance notice of trail closure with NO FUEL in Plymouth. Grooming all the way to route 100 still.
