More About Goal #1: Self-Empowerment

- Promote self-directed learning with information found on chapter website at: ncbwaamd.org ("We Care")
- Share dates/links to wide range of e-Resources
 & Townhall Meetings with C-19 Subject Matter
 Experts (SMEs)
- Encourage questions from the public to be shared with SMEs to develop/ post FAQs on website
- Host 2+ Virtual Town Hall meetings with SMEs



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More About Goal #2: Community Mobilization to Facilitate "Herd Immunity"

• Moving *Beyond Education* to <u>Mobilization</u> through:

- Collaborations with Community Partners (e.g., AACHD, CAA, others?) and "We Care" Supporters/Allies (i.e., *likeminded organizations -* NAACP, sororities, civic organizations);
- Personal Outreach/Educational Advocacy by Members/Allies to their personal networks (e.g., family, friends, co-workers, church family, others);
- Host 1+ Press Conference(s) with members, *key influencers/civic leaders*, allies willing to "take the shot";
- Recruit Vaccine Volunteers for boots on the ground to push-out the messaging (post/distribute flyers, calm fears/break *hesitancy* at vaccine clinics)



More About Goal #3: Preparing for the *Fire Next Time*

- Document the Project and the Journey through Informationsharing/Information-Collection (surveys, interviews, "vaccine journals", other):
 - Solicit Member/Community feedback_
 - <u>Why Hesitant/Reluctant</u>? (e.g., myths, rumors, lies, simply lacking information?)
 - What helped to change your heart and your mind?
 - Document Lessons Learned (from publicity/members/partners/allies)
 - Develop a *White Paper* to be shared with:
 - Academics/Researchers/Practitioners/Policy-makers/Others?





"The Ask": Members/ Partners/Allies Can Help by...

• **Providing:**

- Volunteer Efforts (data-collection, onsite support @ vaccine clinics)
- ✓ Financial or relevant in-kind services: such as donations, printing, gift cards
- ✓ Subject Matter Experts: townhall meetings, public inquiries/developing FAQs
- Community Influence: written consent to use org name/logo; secure member commitments to take vaccine for press conference/volunteer with data-collection at vaccine clinics; entre to communities of color
- ✓ Facilities, staffing as appropriate for "meeting the people" where they are, and administering the vaccines in local settings(e.g., community centers, church fellowship halls, clinics, similar?)
