

All 28 members with 3 guests were welcomed. Members were reminded to check their emails and club website for last minute changes to club activities. Bob McVane made a motion to accept the minutes as published in the October 2023 Highgrader. Hank Householter seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed. Treasurer Mark Hedges presented the treasurers report for October 2023. Steve Hulse motioned to accept the Treasurers report and was seconded by Don Goodwin. All were in favor and the motion passed.
