


Butterfly class home activities

Once you have watched the story discuss the following with your child :

- Can they remember what baby bear took to the moon?

What would they like to take to the moon? Can they draw a picture of what they would take?



Don't forget to take a photo of their picture and send it in to us!




- Who did baby bear see on his way to the moon?
- What did they do on the moon?

Have a picnic with your child at home, maybe they can find their own space shoes or boots and a helmet to wear! Don't forget to take photo's of your picnic and send them to us.



While looking at the story encourage your child to think about any shapes they might be able to see, for example, talk about the shape of the moon or the bricks of the house. Go on a shape hunt around your home. How many circles, squares, triangles and rectangles can they see?



Help your child to record how many of each shape they can find. You could use the tally chart already made or make your own.

This week we would also like you to explore the letter i. Have a look at Mrs Leer demonstrating this new sound. (Click video link below)

Can your child identify the picture that begins with i?



Can they remember the initial sound of the other pictures?

This week you can watch Mrs Leer forming the letter i. Have a go with your child.

Support your child to form a large letter i in the air with their finger.



Now see if your child can form the letter i . How about trying this in shaving foam or a tray of flour!

When your child has learnt the 'i' sound see if they can remember 's', 'a', 't' and 'p' from previous weeks. How many words can they think of that begin with these letters? Can they form these independently?
