REMINDER

All Dog tag/ kennel licenses are due as of **April 1, 2017**. After that date owners purchasing dog tags/ kennel fees will be subject to the following fee schedule:

\$7.00 Spayed/Neutered

\$9.00 Unaltered Pets

\$40.00 Kennel License (3+dogs)

Don't forget we will need a copy of your current rabies vaccination before you can purchase your tag(s).



STORM Shelter & SIREN Policy

Ever get tired of hearing the annoying siren at noon every weekday? We do too, but storm season is fast approaching and sounding the sirens helps the City ensure the siren system is maintained in good working order. Moran has two storm shelters, one is located

behind City Hall with the second located at the City Park. Additionally, the Moran Fire Department uses the sirens to alert volunteer firemen when fire calls are received.



Sirens are sounded as follows:

DAILY—all sirens sounded for 10 seconds at noon Monday through Friday

TORNADO—sirens sound continually for 3 minutes with a 10 second pause between sirens. All clear is one 10 second siren

CITY FIRE—sirens sound once for 10 seconds

RURAL FIRE—sirens sound twice for 10 seconds each

SEVERE WEATHER SIREN SITE LOCATIONS

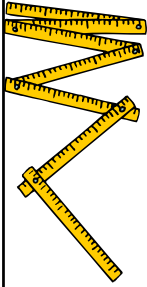
- 1st & Cedar; located near the United Methodist Church

Moran City Code 8-402(e)



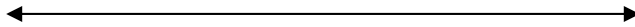
Moran enforces grass height regulations on properties within the City limits. Maximum grass and weed height is 12 inches. Notice of violation is given **ONCE** at the beginning of each growing season. Should the property owner not comply within one week of the notice, the City will mow the property at a cost of \$100.00 per hour, with a minimum charge of \$100.00 which will be **charged to the property owner**.

~Please do not mow grass clippings onto roadways~

(This includes alleys, streets, and Highways 54 & 59)

Doing so can lead to a breakdown of the road surface as the clippings decompose. Grass seed establishes roots in crevices of the surface, causing more damage by expanding the crevices as the grass grows.

When mowing your lawn, please start by making several passes so that clippings are blown back into your yard. This will prevent clippings in the roadway.



13-213. BURNING IN STREETS. It shall be unlawful for any person to make or cause to be made, any fire upon any of the paved streets, alleys, or street intersection within the city.



Burn Permits are REQUIRED

7-702. BURNING: UNLAWFUL (a): It is unlawful for any person or persons to burn or permit or cause to be burned any garbage deposited in a garbage container or any refuse burner in the city. It is further unlawful to burn any garbage in any trash or refuse container in connection with any combustible trash.

Curb Side Service will be May 23rd

Please separate wood and metal items and place near the roadway for easy access. Break or cut wood and brush items into 4' lengths and bundle together near the roadway.

Alternative Location: For your convenience, a roll-off dumpster will be located at the City Park from May 19th through May 26th should you wish to dispose of items immediately.

The following items will be collected:

Boxes Scrap Metal
 Furniture Carpeting
 Logs, branches, tree trimmings

These items will not be collected:

Tires Batteries
 Motor Oil Dead Animals
 Household hazardous materials
 Appliances with Freon
