

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 23, 1994

MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. THIRTY FOUR MEMBERS PRESENT.  
COMMANDER LEO MILHAM PRESIDING.

AFTER ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS. THE ADJUTANT READ THE MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING. MINUTES ACCEPTED AS READ.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

HOSPITAL VISITATION-VINNY ZANGARI REPORTED THAT HE VISITED BILL MALAST. BILL HAD A STROKE AND IS PARTIALLY PARALYZED ON HIS LEFT SIDE.

MEMBERSHIP-CHARLIE FONTANA REPORTED WE HAVE 150 MEMBERS PAID AS OF TONIGHT. DUES ARE COMING IN SLOWER NOW AND HE REQUESTED MEMBERS PAY THEIR DUES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

POST ACTIVITIES CHARLIE FONTANA SAID THERE ARE STILL SOME OPENINGS FOR THE ITALIAN NIGHT DINNER DANCE ON OCTOBER 15. THE PREVIOUS NIGHT ON OCT. 14, THE POST WILL HAVE INSTALLATION OF OFFICERS CEREMONIES. CHARLIE PLANS TO HAVE HOT FOOD SERVED AND WANTED TO KNOW APPROXIMATELY THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE PLANNING TO ATTEND.
