#### Specialized Training for BAs

McKinsey offers a series of targeted training programs to help you succeed in your role as a business analyst... and beyond.

Business Skills Program: Prior to joining the firm, analysts with no previous formal business or finance experience may be invited to attend a 3- to 4-week training course in business basics taught by expert faculty.

Basic Consulting Readiness: BCR is a week-long program that offers an introduction to McKinsey, our people, and our values. You learn how we work in teams, Interact with clients, and approach problems, and get a chance to meet your new colleagues.

Business Analyst Training: BAT is a 1-week course in advanced problem solving, interpersonal, and communications skills. You usually attend BAT within 6 to 12 months of joining the firm. The course is a great chance to revisit topics from BCR in more depth, strengthen core skills based on your team experiences, and to expand your McKinsey network by spending time with BAs from other offices.

## An accelerated beginning to a successful career

Your role as a business analyst at McKinsey can be the beginning of a long association with the firm, or a broadening experience for other careers. After 2 years, analysts go on to pursue a range of career opportunities both within the firm and beyond. Many go on to graduate school or to work in industry. Still other high-performing BAs spend a third year with McKinsey in a more specialized role or in an international location before going on to graduate school. In exceptional circumstances, given an individual's performance and desire, some BAs move directly into an associate position with the firm.

McKinsey BAs have gone on to significant leadership roles within the firm as partners, and beyond the firm as presidents and managing partners of venture capital companies, and founders and CEOs of dot.coms. Others have achieved high-profile positions as elected officials and policy advisors in governments around the world and at leading universities.
