


The rider courses in the GWRRA Rider Education Program teach us to look out for anything happening around us while we ride. If you have taken an ARC or TRC class, you might remember the slide that shows this



Look at it closely. Your position is the figure of the motorcycle in the middle. We are assuming in this picture you have a co-rider or at least where the co-rider should be looking. The 2 second zone is the point at which you need to take action. The 4 second zone is when you need to be looking to act. The 12 second zone is the area you need to searching/scanning for potential threads to you.
