A Note from Rick: Well, this was the week for changes in the markets at TLA on Tuesday and Thursday. After a long stretch of very consistent markets, our markets were softer this week. Slaughter cows were \$2-\$4 lower on Tuesday. The calf market was steady to slightly lower. We also sold a 50 cow herd of dairy cows on Tuesday and they sold in line with the way dairy cows have been selling for quite some time. Younger, fresher cows from \$1,200-\$1,400 and older cows or mid to late lactation cows from \$800-\$1,100. Prices at the September springer auction on Thursday didn't hold up to prices from the August sale. In August, prices jumped \$150-\$200 higher per head and that is just about exactly how much they were off in September. We had an excellent set of springers to offer. They just fell back in the \$1,300-\$1,500 range on the #1s and \$1,000-\$1,200 on the majority of the rest. The Labor Day Pony Auction was definitely a success. It was one of the best Fall Pony Sales that we've had. The arena was packed and a great time was had by all ages. It was a fun day to be at TLA. The Morgan Classic on the 11th and 12th was a dandy as well with several major highlights. The Friesian Fall Classic and Fall Draft Horse books are at the printer and it looks to be an exciting Fall at TLA! Hope to see you soon.
