



Credits, Articulations & Prerequisites

Credits:

Cross credit with some academic courses (including 4th year related math, VPAA, math & science) may be available and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis with each district's counseling department.

Prerequisites:

- Junior or 11th grade in credits
- Attendance in the 90%
- Interview & orientation with Riverview School of Cosmetology- acceptance in the program
- Students must achieve a minimum hour requirement set by Riverview School of Cosmetology in order to move forward into the second half of the program.

This program offers excellent career opportunities for both male and female students.



Program Description

This is a two-year program for students to earn the state required hours in the field of cosmetology. Once accepted into the program, students will be trained by licensed cosmetology educators in a hands-on environment conducive with salon reality.

Due to the state requirements, this program demands excellent attendance, strong commitment, and some monetary funding from both student and parent/guardian. The schedule is also subject to change depending on class size. The schedule will also continue into the summer months and will require Saturday attendance. With the program's hours requirement, the ability to prioritize activities is essential.

The program is structured based on state requirements. The first 350 hours will be when you learn the basics of cosmetology. After 350 hours the students will be able to work hands on with real guests until they complete their required 1500 hours. The goal is to prepare them for not only passing their licensing exam, but also to prepare them to launch a sustainable career.

Special Features

Ideally, students will have their own transportation for both to and from the program. Transportation to the Riverview School of Cosmetology can be accessed through the DCTC bus hub. Program class time is 11:00 – 3:30. Transportation from Riverview School of Cosmetology is the student/parent/guardian responsibility. Saturdays, when scheduled, will require transportation for both to and from the program.
