CRAB ORCHARD ROAD AND BEECH AVE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT – PHASE II

Separate sealed Bids for the construction of the **Crab Orchard Road & Beech Avenue Waterline Replacement Project – Phase II** will be received by Russell A. Mullins., Town Manager, at the Town of Coeburn Offices, 403 Second St. NE (Carrier) or P.O. box 370 (Mail), Coeburn, Virginia 24230 until **2:30 p.m.** local time on **Thursday, April 4, 2019**, at which time the Bids received will be **publicly opened and read aloud.**

The Project consists of the replacement of approximately 1,918 lf of 4-inch, 570 lf of 2-inch, 565 lf of ¾ inch waterline; the reconnecting of 15 existing services and two (2) existing hydro-pneumatic water tanks; and associated appurtenances.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis. The Project is funded through the **Virginia Department of Health.**

MBE/WBE firms are encouraged to submit bids. Bidders must comply with the following: the President's Executive Order # 11246 prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, color, creed, sex, or national origin; the President's Executive Orders # 12138 and 11625 regarding utilization of MBE/WBE firms; the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act; and Section 436 of P.L. 113-76 American Iron and Steel. Bidders must certify that they do not or will not maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on the basis of race, color, creed, or national origin.

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of **\$200.00** for each set. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 15 days after receipt of Bids will be refunded 50% of their deposit. Contractors have the option to purchase an electronic set of bidding documents (Adobe PDF Format) for a \$50.00 non-refundable fee. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to The Lane Group, Inc. Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **10:00 a.m.** local time on **Tuesday, March 26, 2019** at the Town of Coeburn Train Depot, 502 Front Street, Coeburn, Virginia 24230. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged; however, it is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The bidder may withdrawal its bid within 24-hours of opening by filing a duly signed written notice with the Owner and promptly thereafter demonstrates to the reasonable satisfaction of Owner that there was a material and substantial mistake in the preparation of its bid, that bidder may withdrawal its bid, and the bid security will be returned. Thereafter, if the work is rebid, the bidder will be disqualified from further bidding on the work.
