Black and tan Marblewood riser. Bow has no delamination: limbs are straight. No drilled holes; No chips or dings. No crazing or stress cracks. There was one shallow superficial stress crack in the riser, which was filled (see pic on last page). I don't believe this to be an issue and will warranty the hairline crack from splitting). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in good condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.

Comes with a new rug rest and string.

Although I don't guarantee or warranty any of my vintage bows (they are all 45-65 years old), I will warranty the bow riser on this Mustang from splitting for 2 years. If the riser splits within 2 years of purchase, I will refund your full purchase price, including shipping.
