HOUSE OF THE CARPENTER

Construction on the new Toni and Nancy Bedway Center for Youth at the House of the Carpenter is moving along rapidly. As of January 31st, it was over 50% complete. The timeline allows for an opening in early June. Our thanks to everyone who has helped to turn this vision of ministry with at risk children, youth and families a reality.

As we move into the final stage, there are numerous ways that you can help us bring this project to completion.

- The “Buy a Block” program to help raise construction funds is still ongoing. We have had over 5,300 blocks purchased raising over \$80,000. We still need to have 3,700 more blocks purchased to pay for all of the walls.
- We are purchasing equipment for the Center. Right now we are focused on:
 - 15 boy’s basketballs @ \$30 each
 - 15 girl’s basketballs @ \$30 each
 - 2 basketball racks @ \$75 each
 - 30 volleyballs @ \$25 each
 - 1 volleyball container basket @ \$150

The staff is currently also working to develop an archery program, a dance program, a theater program and an afterschool program. Please keep your eyes open for the day we have an open house. Again, thank you for your help and we look forward to sharing this ministry together.
