LCRA Approves Biz Plan

During the past few years of terrible drought in Texas the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) was often one of the most maligned official agencies in Texas. They manage the waters of the Colorado River and when its dry, nobody gets enough water to suit them, and we have to blame whoever is in charge of distributing the little water we have. And, of course there's the problem of not only high utility cost, but also the LCRA's coal and gas fired power plants that are often blamed for eco-events we don't like in our state.

Yesterday, word came out from LCRA that their Board of Directors had approved their \$858 million business plan for FY 2017 and it includes some \$410 million for capital improvement, as well as a plan to reduce costs that should bring some \$350 million in rate relief to wholesale power customers such as the City of Lampasas and Hamilton and Pedernales Electric Co-ops.

Another big plus in their plan is to get started on a new reservoir at Lane City, near the coast. The reservoir could impound 90,000 acre ft. of water, which would take much of the demand from Lakes Buchanan and Travis. That would make lots of people around the Highland Lakes and in the Austin area happy if their lakes weren't being drained down every summer to provide water for the coast. The Lane City Reservoir should be finished and operating in 2018.

If everything goes as planned, we'll all be a lot happier with the LCRA. Here's hoping!

Boys & Girls Club Fundraiser at Hoffpauir's Barn Saturday

Large numbers of Lampasas and area people with invites and tickets in hand will be at a gala fundraiser at the Lee and Kathleen Blumel Hoffpauir Barn on FM 580 on Saturday evening. The Hoffpauir event comes on the heels of a similar event, the Catkins Ball in San Saba, which took place three weeks ago and raised well over \$100,000 for San Saba's various community revitalization and historic preservation projects.
