**RESTORATION INFORMATION MEETING** will be held after 10am mass this weekend to present the findings of the report by the contractor. Refer to the supporting budget description of September 28/2018.

The objective of the required 6 to 8 months is that these items stated can be achieved through Phasing, three phases have been discussed:

Phase 1- Ceiling venting, walls of nave treated, and the sanctuary completed.

Phase 2- Paintings/pattern on upper clerestory, murals and the side vaults with stencils.

Phase 3- Ceiling restored, decorated and balcony high wall finished.

**ESTIMATED BUDGET**: <u>Phase 1</u> - \$142,500; <u>Phase 2</u> - \$135,840; <u>Phase 3</u> - \$ 85,500; <u>Scaffolding</u>- \$ 26,400 and <u>accommodations</u>-\$ 1,400 monthly for 6 to 8 months. These alone costs \$450,000 including HST.

**If we have funds available**, then we will be able to update the church Lighting which is budgeted at \$48,600.
