

RULES FOR TOMBSTONE

At the first tee, you will see a blue bin with wooden crosses inside. Use a jiffy marker and print your first initial and last name on the tape and your handicap added to the course par. Example: Course par is 70, blue and white tees and 67 from the gold tees. Write that number next to your name, add your handicap, and this is your target. The objective is to shoot below that score, and bring the tombstone back and qualify for a prize.

Remember

If this player's score is par or higher on the last hole, he is dead. The tombstone is placed beside the 18th green. Any time you reach the combined score your cross goes in the ground.

If your shot ends on a green, place your cross just off the fringe.

To win a prize you must shoot below your combined score and handicap.

For example this player must shoot 91 or less by the last hole in order to win a prize.

Have fun and shoot low!
