A big thank you to our Navajo Canyon RWF members that attended or hosted our club's volunteer days at member's homes for Reform California. We stuffed 3,000 plus envelopes with information about the Upcoming effort to pass a gas tax for every driver in California. These letters were mailed out to Republican, Independent and even certain Democrat voters, across California to raise awareness of the Democrat's efforts to push through a gas tax at the local level using bureaucrats instead of elected officials who might cave under public pressure.
