Directions: Find a group of people with the fewest number of participants whom you already know. Form into groups of 5-6 (at least two groups per table). Identify someone to write down what is discussed. Read the questions and decide together which ones you think are most important to answer. Then discuss those questions as a small group. Start with the most important question! Freely enter and exit groups. Remember to listen and give everyone a chance to speak. Speak from your own personal point of view.

Questions for Discussion

(10-15 minutes per question/Choose any 3-to-4 questions to answer):

1. What does "home" mean to you?
2. What is "affordable" housing? How much of your income do you believe should go to housing? Can you find housing in your budget in Scott County?
3. What makes the neighborhood where you live feel welcoming – or not welcoming?
4. What type of home or housing do you need to feel healthy?
5. Is there something Scott County could do to help provide more affordable housing? Are there other kinds of housing options that are needed? What are they?
6. Is there something about your cultural story that is important in a conversation about housing?
7. Are there resources that you know of to help find housing in Scott County? What are they?
8. Do you work and live in the same city or town? If not, would you like to?
9. Does transportation play a role in your current housing situation? What is that role?
10. Is there anything we didn't we ask that should be asked? Share the question and your answer to it as well.

- Take notes about things your group thinks important to note in the space provided.
- Please write legibly or ask someone who writes legibly to write the notes.
- Be prepared to share your findings with the larger group.
