### May 2023 festivals in Florida

Sunfest, West Palm Beach, May 4-7, 2023

With a stunning waterfront view along Flagler Drive, this major

music festival offers three stages, 50 bands and lots of activities beyond musical performances.

#### Tampa Riverfest, Tampa, May 5-6, 2023

Tampa's scenic linear park has a free two-day festival that includes a taco fest and a lighted lantern parade, where attendees can design lanterns and participate in the parade. Other activities include music by locals bands, a balloon glow at sunset both nights, a paddle invasion and more. The adjoining RiverFiesta requires buying a wrist band and includes the chance to sample foods. Curtis Hixon Waterfront Park, 600 N Ashley Drive, Tampa.

### <u>Isle of Eight Flags Shrimp Festival</u>, **Fernandina Beach**, **May 5-7**, **2023**

This will be the 56th annual shrimp festival in one of Florida's most productive shrimp regions. Pirate Parade, exhibits, arts and crafts, antiques, games, contests, seafood and live music along the Amelia River in downtown Fernandina Beach.

### <u>Key West Singers and Songwriters Festival</u>, **Key West**, **May 3-7**, **2023**

Musical performances and conversations with major artists. Most shows are free and occur at beaches, boats, bars, resorts and theaters. Shows start early afternoon and play into the late night.

Redland International Orchid Festival, Redland, May 19-21
This event takes place at fascinating Fruit and Spice Park, 24801
SW 187th Ave., Redland, and features some of the top orchid growers in the world. It is one of the oldest, largest and most prestigious orchid events in the country. It includes live music and food. Best deal is to buy tickets in advance; tickets include admission to the park.

#### Tupelo Honey Festival, Wewahitchka, May 20, 2023

Where is Wewahitchka and what exactly is Tupelo honey (other than a Van Morrison song)? Wewahitchka is in the Big Bend region of Florida near Tallahassee. Tupelo honey is a seasonal delicacy because Tupelo trees only bloom from April to May and top-quality honey comes from only the trees in the Apalachicola River valley. It

is so special that you won't find it in stores. At this festival, farmers from the area offer honey in a variety of sizes and packages under the moss-draped oaks around Lake Alice. The small-town festival also offers food vendors, art and crafts, live music and, of course, there is a Miss Tupelo Honey gueen.

### Florida Folk Festival, Memorial Day Weekend, White Springs, May 26-28, 2023
