COVID-19 Update

July 29, 2020

Dear Church Family,

As a pastoral staff, we wanted to let you know what we are doing in trying to get us back together as a church family. First, we want to encourage everyone to attend our services if you are feeling well enough or if you do not feel vulnerable in any way. Second, if you feel for your safety being back in groups of people, we would like to encourage you to continue participating remotely. Now let us explain what we are going to try to do at least for the next month. We are only able to make decisions from month to month, so we appreciate your flexibility and understanding at this time.

We are working on a hybrid service to incorporate elements of the traditional service, our family worship, our online worshippers, and Sabbath School (which we hope to restart soon). We will begin our service at 10:30 a.m. to incorporate all these elements.

What everyone thinks or considers our "regular" service we are not going to be able to do for quite some time. Things that involve passing the offering plate or lamb's offering we are not able to do and will not be able to do for the foreseeable future. Also, we cannot have the children gather in a group for children's story (we are still going to have a story of some type, though). Also, we have had to remove all the hymnals, Bibles, and tithe envelopes from the pews (due to cleaning requirements). If you have your own Bible, hymnal, or apps on your devices, we encourage you to bring

them. Also, we are not able to have any shared meals (fellowship meals) until further notice. There will be no printed materials (bulletins) to share publicly (hopefully we can have these available for personal pick-up soon). We are to practice social distancing and sit every other pew. Also, inside the building, we are encouraging the use of facemasks unless you are leading out in the service.

We know that many of you were looking forward to coming back to regular service, and hopefully, in the future, we will be able to return to it. We ask for your patience and prayers as we make decisions to try to protect as many people as possible, working with the guidance of the Texas Conference, the State of Texas, and our local authorities.

Please pray for those who are sick and for all those who are caring for them.

Please pray for our school, the teachers, and the students, as we are planning on returning to "in-person" classes on August 17.

We hope to see you all at church, but if you are unable to attend in person, continue joining us at 10:30 a.m. each Sabbath as we come to you live from our sanctuary at the Joshua Seventh-day Adventist Church on our Facebook page, our website, and our YouTube channel.

We are looking forward to seeing you all in person.

GUATEMALA SHIPPING CONTAINER

NEEDS LIST

International Children's Care is a Seventh-day Adventist orphan-care ministry that has been helping children around the world since 1978. A half-shipping container, 20ft long, needs to be filled to send to help the orphan children in Guatemala. Thank you for blessing the children with your prayers and love.

You can make a world of difference by taking this project on as a mission project at your church. Find out more information by contacting Makala James, Southwest Regional Coordinator, at 817-714-7308. Following is a list of needed items.

- Fitted twin-size bed sheets (We have a supply of flat bed sheets.)
- Bath towels, hand towels, etc.
- Clothing and shoes for church and play, especially for ages 6-12. Winter clothes are not needed, as it remains warm throughout the year.
- Toiletries (Shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, bath soap, etc.)
- Laundry detergent, cleaning supplies
- 10 electric space heaters to use in the living rooms when it is cold during the winter months
- Large tents for the Pathfinder Club and screened tent room for food prep when it is raining at campouts.
- Copy paper for school and admin. (This is a HUGE blessing for them.)
- Backpacks
- School supplies: Wide rule paper, #2 pencils, pens, rulers, protractors, composition notebooks, colored pencils, etc. (No wax crayons ~ They will melt!)
- Bolts of fabric to make clothes (Lightweight fabric, because most of the year it is warm in Guatemala)
- Sturdy coffee tables and end tables for the families (10 homes)

In addition to donating lightly used, second hand, or new items, when you send a financial gift to support the shipping costs of the container, every \$1 you donate is able to deliver up to \$4 of vital materials and supplies!
