

NEW MEXICO PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSION
Utility Division Director II (GOVEX)

The Utilities Division Director is responsible for the supervision and management of all operations and staff assigned to the Utility Division which includes accounting, economic, and engineering professionals. The division director acts in regulatory matters as an independent party, representing the general public and presenting expert testimony in the fields of engineering, economics, accountancy and rate structure

Essential Job Functions:

- Plans, organizes, integrates and coordinates the work of the Utilities Division
- Assign and investigate consumer complaints
- Represents the public interest in utility matters before the Commission
- Actively participate in special projects, working groups, settlement negotiations, mediation process of an accounting or economic nature.
- Review and analyze testimony, exhibits, interrogatory responses, utility books and records, computer models, State and Federal Statutes, rules and regulations, court decisions relating to cost of service, cost of capital, rate design, financial markets, tax issues and all other electric, water, or sewer utility related accounting and economic issues in accordance with procedural schedules ordered by the NMPRC.
- Provide comments on state and federal level Notices of Inquiry and Notices of Proposed Rulemakings in accordance with procedural schedules

Minimum qualifications: Bachelor's degree in business, finance, engineering, economics, accounting, with 7 years of experience in the public utility and/or telecommunications sector or public utility and/or telecommunications regulation. Four (4) years of supervisory experience is required.

Salary: \$53,557.92– \$120,000.00 per year (with benefits). Salary based on qualifications and experience. This is a GOVEX "At Will" position. The State of NM is an EOE Employer.
