Below are the 2 research areas that we have chosen to sponsor in 2015. We donated \$2,500 from our AKC CHF donor advised fund to each one. We will be notified when the specific grants from each research program are chosen. We will keep you posted as we receive updates.

Immunology and Infectious Disease Research Program RFP

Due Date for Grant Applications: April 6, 2015

The AKC Canine Health Foundation is requesting basic science, discovery and clinical research that will aid in the prevention and treatment of infectious and allergic disease. Research including the role of immune function in the pathogenesis of disease, relevance of infection in the development and exacerbation of allergic diseases; identification of novel therapeutics and new diagnostic tests, and the role of environmental allergens and/or genetic background as risk factors for the development of allergic diseases is all considered responsive. As with all CHF research programs, collaborative, multi-disciplinary teams of investigators who can approach discovery research from a multi-'omics' perspective will be considered more competitive than genomic research approaches working in isolation. Grants are requested for the following topics:

- · Food Allergy
 - Including research into skin and/or gastrointestinal manifestations of disease
- Development of Non-Antibiotic Antibacterial Agents
- CHF seeks to fund pilot projects that will stimulate discovery efforts and/or early-stage development of novel
 therapies for treatment of infections caused by bacterial pathogens of significant clinical concern that are
 rapidly becoming resistant to currently approved drugs. Research can include efforts to target bacterial
 virulence factors or transport mechanisms; identification of novel host-directed therapeutics
 (immunomodulators); novel biologics such as monoclonal antibodies and peptides.

Senior Dog Health and Wellness Research Program Area RFP Due Date for Grant Applications: June 1, 2015

Senior dogs currently make up roughly 40% of the patient population in veterinary practices and have unique health concerns. The AKC Canine Health Foundation seeks to award research that will stimulate novel approaches to senior dog healthcare.

Grants are requested for the following topics:

- Relationship between 'inflammaging' and gastrointestinal health or cognitive function in senior dogs
- Use of rehabilitation to preserve cognitive function in older dogs
