Derbyshire County Council 'difficulties' mean we need to stand together

Following closely the troubles at Birmingham City Council and more recent government intervention there, for the second largest county council employer in England to make such an announcement is of great concern.

All Derbyshire UNISON members working for the council should have received an email from UNISON explaining exactly what we know so far and challenging the idea that the financial troubles providing services for councils! are in any way to do with salaries. (Check junk email/spam boxes if you haven't yet seen it).

The vast majority of local government workers are far too lowly paid. It is the government's slash and burn measures, seeking short-term financial gains at the expense of everything else, which are to blame. Councils need more money; much of which is going into the profits of businesses Initial measures being taken by the council of recruitment freezes and cutting back on most agency staff will clearly affect not just on budgets but the services provided and in potential knockon effects on permanent staff job
