"AS IT WAS IN THE DAYS OF NOAH."

HIS striking reference to the days of Noah should be carefully considered by every Christian

First; Because it discovers to us the exact time of Redemption Seven days before the rain fell, God commanded Noah to enter the ark, and God shut to the door. (Gen. 7.)

The prophet says: "Take a year for a day and a day for a year." Thus, seven years b fore the Lord comes to earth again, the saints will go into Redemption, the dead raised, the living changed and the door of mercy will close on this ungodly and perverse generation.

Second: To define this time more carefully, by a comprehensive view of the Bible, the Jews are to rehabitate Palestine seven years before the Lord descends, or the 70th week of Dadiel. (Dan. 9:24)

The Jews return in a time of trouble such as there never was. This return occurs at the downfall of Turkey and the release of the Holy Land from being trodden down by the Gentiles, or the closing of the Gentile Age. (Lk. 21:34; Dan. 9:27.)

I call your attention to these facts: the time of trouble is on; Turkey is doomed; the Jews are ready for their restoration: and as they return seven years before the

coming of the Lord, all these events being imminent, our Redemption is at hand. (Lk. 21:18.)

It is in this time of trouble that God's children are to be delivered. whose names are written in the Book of Life. "And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlating contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars forever and ever." (Dan. 12:1-3.)

Third: Russia will speedily turn her whole attention to the conquest of the Cttoman Empire, holding only a defensive line on the German and Austrian Frontiers. This will compel England to change front and fight Russia over their frontiers in Persia and Palestine. Russia will seize Constantinople and England Palestine, and then as a war meas-

ure England will invite the Jews to their own land, and provide ships to carry them. The Bible says they are to be carried by the ships of Chittim. (Dan. 11:30.) Chittim is the land of tin from whence Solomon obtained tin for the temple.

This will insure Britian's position in the near East. The Jews, tired of the world's wars and impending anarchy, will rejoice in their restoration, and fulfill the prophecy:

"Who are these that fly as a cloud, and as doves to their windows?" (Isa. 60:8.)

The remnant (the Bride) will return with them. The Church (His Body) will go into Redemption about this time, and a general condition of anarchy, pestilence and famine will prevail on the earth.

From these things we can readily see our Redemption is nearer than we realize. How thorough, then, ought to be our examination and invoicing of experiences to see how we stand with God. For this hour let us turn our attention to personal purity and perfection of our character in God, rather than the maintaining of missions and factions, churches, creeds and denominationalism.

REDEMPTION.

The necessary preparation for Redemption can only be found in a thoroughly sanctified life. There is no promise except to the overcomer, and no one can live a victor in God without true holiness, and this is only entered by an instantaneous

definite second work of grace. To this must be added the sealing of the Holy Ghost of promise. (Eph. 1: 13, 14.)

The baptism of the Holy Ghost of promise is an essential in your preparation for Redemption, and your experience must tally with the 2nd chap'er of Acts. You may have been wonderfully sanctified and have had the "anointing that abideth," as the disciples rectived from Jesus in the upper room when the door was locked, but no one has the baptism with the Holy Ghost unless their experience tallies with that received on the day of Pentecost.

By the baptism with the Holy Ghost I do not mean all the chattering, jabbering, wind-sucking, holy dancing-rollerism going on over the country, which is the result of hypnotic, spiritualistic and flesly controls, but a real sane reception of the Holy Ghost in baptismal power, filling you with glory unspeakable and causing you, without any effort, to speak freely in foreign languages. This is called the sealing. (Rev. 7; II Cor. 1:22; Eph. 4:30; 1:13, 14.)

This sealing will not preserve you without effort on your part. You must live a clean, holy life on the Pentecostal plane or the sealing loses its validity.

Hear this: Three-fourths of the so called pentecosts in the world are counterfeits, the devil's imitation to deceive the poor earnest souls, so they will not escape the coming time of trouble through Redemption. [CONTINUED ON PAGE 19.1]

AITH HEALING, or DIVINE HEALING.

- 1. By Faith-healing, or Divine-healing, is to be understood the recovery of persons afflicted with serious diseases, by the power of God, in answer to faith and prayer, without the use of ordinary means, such as doctors, medicines, and the like.
- 2. That God should heal the sick after this fashion is in perfect harmony with the views and experience of The Salvation Army from the beginning. Nothing to the contrary has ever been taught by our authority, and numerous instances of faith-healing have occured in The Army throughout its history.
- The teaching of the Bible is in favor of this method of healing. The following passage taken alone proves

fet him call for the elders of the church a utilet them pray over him, anointing about the prayer of faith shall save thankick, and the Lord shall raise him size; and if he have committed in save y shall be forgiven him. Jayrer v, 14, 15.

If there were no other, this passage alone would be afficient; but there are numerous texts in the Book to the same effect.

4. The healing of the sick directly by the power of Ged Las from the beginning been associated and the office of prophets, priests, conners, apostles---and, indeed, all of those, known by whatever name, who

been the agents of God on the earth.

- 5 When Jesus sent forth His apostles, He gave them power not only to preach, but to heal the sick.
- 6. Nevertheless from the beginning there can be no question that God has been pleased to heal sickness and disease by the use of appropriate means. He has, it is true, in some instances chosen to preserve health without food; but, as a rule, if men want to keep health, they must use suitable means. Just so with the restoration of health. when it is lost. Where men are led by the Spirit of God to heal, or be healed, by faith, by all means let it be so, and God will be glorified thereby. But where they are not, let them use such means as commend themselves to their own judgement, and they must not be condemned for so doing.
- 7. The F. O. must beware of being led into false notions on the subject of Faith healing, as multitudes have been.
 - (a) He must not deny Faith-healing, because some say they are healed and are not; or because some have sought healing who have not found it; or because some may have seemed to be healed, and then have been as sick as ever. All these objections would apply to obtaining Salvation by faith.
 - (b) The F. O. must beware of discouraging the faith for healing in others. On the contrary, he should do all he can to urge other people to such faith even if he

is himself unable to exercise it.

(c) He must not consider disease to be sin or suppose that any serious sickness in people proves them to be greater sinners than others. Neither must he suppose that afflict in proves a want of faith in those who endure it, seeing that it may be the will of God they should suffer and not be healed.

8. When Soldiers or others desire to present themselves to God for recovery by faith, or where F.O. is led to seek healing for himself, his Soldiers, or others, in this way, let the following suggestions be attended to:—

(a) Anointing with oil is evidently not essential, seeing that as many cases of healing have been wrought without it as with it. It is but a form. Still, when persons attach importance to it, it can be used.

(b) When oil is used, all that is required is to anoint the forehead with it. To suppose that there is any necessity to apply it to the parts affected is simply ridiculous, for if that line be followed out, it may be said that the oil is essential to the healing. If the cure is wrought by God, touching the forehead with oil serves every purpose.

(c) If patients should insist on being anointed with oil in the seat of the particular malady, women must in every case anoint women, and men must anoint men. And holy women who are firm believers in this way of healing should be selected to perform this duty.

9. Where an Officer has not light upon this subject, or does not feel any power in Faith-healing, then some Sergeant who does, may be requested to deal with those seeking healing in this way.—Orders and Regulations for Field Officers, Salvation Army.—Chap. iv, Sec. 2, page 51.

THE VEIL OF PROPHECY LIFTED.

Extracts From Sermon by Chas. F. Parham, on "The Future Outlook.

Since so much interest has been aroused in this and other countries by these prophetic lectures, I feel the main work of my ministry must now be lifting the veil of prophecy so that the "wise" everywhere may "hear and understand."

Last week a man in Portugal wrote desiring the privilege of translating my sermon on "War, War, War," and distributing it over Europe.

We are now in the War of the Nations.—Matt, 24:6-7. This present conflict will destroy the German, Austrian and Turkish Empires, as the three countries that rib Russia.—Dan. 7:5. With the overthrow of Turkey the Gentile Age closes, and the Jews are rehabitated in Palestine. The coalition of Italy and three other countries will soon appear as the Leopard.—Dan. 7:6.

This will prepare the way for the "Diverse Beast" (Anarchy).—Dan. 7:7. Diverse because it is an unorganized power, while all the others have been on an organized basis.

England will lose her colonies by secession and otherwise, the Kings of Europe will fall and a baptism of blood will follow. In the United States, Capital and Labor will clash, the government will fall, the streets of our cities will run with blood, and she who yesterday sat in her palace of luxury, will tomorrow search among the ruins of her former home for relics of her lost wealth, wearing the garb of charity and fed on public alms-

Then the "Woman" (Catholicism) riding on the back of the "Beast" (Anarchy), will assert her power.—Rev. 17:17. She alone controls suf-

ficient of the consciences of men to restore order. When order is restored the masses alone remain, the Kings and the rich having perished. Then will come a great ethical wave (a Lamb-like power), and a great teacher and leader arising will lead the masses into a sort of Socialistic, Ethical, Humanitarianism, to which even the Pope will agree, and he will appoint ten men (kings, or toes), or Captains of Industries to rule the world in a commission form of government similar to Bellamy's "Looking Backward."-Rev. 17:7, 18; Dan. 7:19-25.

All phases of spiritual or experimental salvation will disappear, and Pantheism, or man his own savior, will exclude everything of the past. Great teachers and schools will spread this new light, this earth-born limitation of Christianity, and so great will be the peace and plenty that fill the world, that man will declare he has produced the Kingdom of God on earth (the true Millennium).

The world, with perhaps the exception of Russia, will be swept by this wave of Socialitsic (two-horned lamb), Humanitarian, Ten-toed, Ten-horned power. A United Brother-hood of Man will be built on the ashes where lay all the unions, combines, lodges, churches and governments of the past.

Oh, what a seeming triumph for puny man; but alas, how soon it passes.

In the middle of the last week of years (seven years) of this Age, the Wonder (man), the great Ethical, Pantheistic, Socialistic, Humanitarian Teacher is wounded to death by the sword in Jerusalem (which will soon become and continue to be for all ages the Hub of the world, the true Zion of God).

All the world will mourn this man as the greatest of earth's creatures, when lo, he comes to life, and all the world, astounded, stand ready to believe him in all things. But into his dead body has crept the spirit of Antichrist, and he is no longer the Great Teacher, or Ethical leader they all adored, but the slimy, deceptive Devil in human form, to work his last deception on the human race.—Rev. 13:3, 11, 12; Rev. 17:10-11.

He decieves the Jews into believing he is their long expected Messiah. He fulfills all their prophecies by bringing into the world a great Ethical Union, with Jerusalem the Chief City. He dies an innocent death and is resurrected in three days. This is He!

Unbounded will be their worship and adoration. The Pope now yields, declares him the Christ, and with the consent of the Jews, gives up the daily sacrifice in the rebuilt Temple, and an Image of the Anti-christ is put in the Holy of Holies.—Dan. 8:11; 11:31; 12:11; Matt. 24:15; Rev. 13:14.

Then the power of the Devil is yielded to him, and all the Christian Scientific, Spiritualistic, Theosophical "tommy-rot" will find their true head. In fact, he will at once, by the reason of his being the Teacher who led the world into this great Ethical Pantheistic Unity, be the supreme political power. The Jewish acceptance of him as the Messiah, the Pope (as the False Prophet) declaring him to be the Christ, and endowed by the Devil with miracles and all deceivableness of iniquity, making fire to come down out of heaven, and the Image to both walk and speak, he becomes the Supreme Head of mankind, the climax of all man's fight against God, "sitting in the Temple of God showing himself that he is God."-II Thes. 2:3-4; Rev. 13:11-14.

With fanatical zeal never before known, the False Prophet (the Pope) will worship this man and seek the establishment of his power in all the earth.

From Universal Brotherhood a reaction occurs, heaving the people into a world-wide Union. An order is issued compelling everyone to take a stamp or seal in the right hand or forehead, and without which they can neither buy nor sell.—Rev. 13:15-18; Luke 21:28-36.

About this time the jealousy of the King of the North, the Czar of all the Russians, is excited by the supremacy of this great King of the South at Jerusalem, and then comes the titanic struggle for the one-man rule, or Imperialistic supremacy of the earth .-Dan. 11:40. They will push one at another until Russia comes down with all her forces (Dan. 11:40-45), passes southeast of Jordan into Egypt, gathers her forces of Ethiopia, and hearing tidings from the east and north. hurriedly marches against the Antichrist at Jerusalem, attacks the city and captures a part .- Zech. 14.

'Tis then the Sign of the coming of the Son of Man astonishes both armies and by an armistice they gather all the fighting forces in the Valley of Esdraleon; the heavens open and Christ descends.—Rev. 19; Zech. 14. After leaving those who came with him in the valley made by the split in the Mount of Olives when His foot touches it, He passes to the battlefield and destroys the fighting forces of the world in one battle—Armageddon.

Then He establishes the true Millennium. "The Government shall be upon His shoulders, and of that Kingdom there shall be no end."

The redemption of mankind will not come upon the earth by man's efforts to redeem himself, but by the coming of the Great Redeemer. All glory and majesty and power be unto Him. Some day we shall lay our crowns at His feet and crown Him Lord of all.

WILL A MAN ROB GOD?

Everywhere we meet hundreds of professors of religion who have a constant struggle to make a living for themseives and family. Everything they do seems to plunge them deeper into debt. Then when the question of tithing is mentioned, their excuse for not having any money is because it takes every cent they make to supply the actual necessities of their lives.

Shortly after the Lord wonderfully saved and healed me, being harassed day and night on account of debt, not knowing which way to turn for relief, I completely surrendered the whole thing to God, laid everything on the altar to be used by Him as He saw fit. I gave Him more than a tenth of our income, and about 30 per cent of my time.

Before this step was taken everything seemed to work against us, but now all things began to work together for our good. When spring came, money, which under ordinary circumstances would have been taken to pay interest on debts (for it was not possible to pay even a PART of the principal), we used to buy a tent and to pay the expenses of workers for the summer's campaign in new fields.

Many tried to make me see that my obligations to man should first be satisfied, but I contended that God came first, and then He would see to it that I would have enough to pay others, because the earth and the fullness thereof belongs to Him and to those who put their trust in Him, and are willing "to try Him." He promises to

open the very windows of heaven and pour out a blessing that there shall not be room enough to contain it.—Mal. 3:8-11.

Knowing my financial condition, and feeling a personal interest in me. many of my friends advised me to take advantage of bankruptcy, settle with my creditors at so much on the dollar, and commence over again. But so convinced was I that God was at the helm of my affairs, and that He never lost a battle, that I continued to pay tithes of both time and money, and God delivered me from debt and with a better standing in the commercial world than I ever had before. To Him be all the praise!

I have recently met a man, who, knowing God in saving and healing power, took the opposite position, that man comes first, and when entirely out of debt to man, then God's demands can be taken care of. The result is, that after five years of grinding from hand to mouth experience, he is no nearer out of debt than at the beginning, and his obligations to God in time and money unsettled and no chance to ever be settled from a human standpoint.

For the sake of humanity and the good of the cause, why not take the Bible way and bring ALL the tithes into the store-house, and prove Him, for the end of the Age is upon us and the night cometh soon when no man can work, and then Your opportunity will be past——J.Ed. Cabaniss.

Palestine for Centuries the Shuttlecock of Nations.

Because England wants a buffer state east of the Suez Canal and Russia finds it must do something for the Jews, the allied powers propose the creation of an independent Palestine. Thus will the scheme of the New Zion propogandists find an unexpected fulfillment of their dream. Thus says a news dispatch from London. Should this dream become a reality it will accomplish even more than has been hoped for

by the Zionists as the Jews who are planning a return to Palestine are known. The Zionists, under the leadership of such men as Zangwill, hold a congress each year. They advocate the return of enough Jews to Palestine to give them the balance of political power the e.

Palestine has been the shuttle-cock of more powerful nations ever since its advent into history. Nothing could be more fitting, now, than that it should be rehabitated in the boundaries of Solomon, to live at the will of its creators.

The Amorites flowed into Palestine about the Sixteenth Century B. C., from the Arabian deserts. A century later Thothmes III enforced an Egyptian overlordship on the land, which his successors maintained for two centuries. Palestine split into a number of petty kingdoms then, which led a precarious existence for two hundred years. By 1100 B. C. the country was overrun by the Hebrews and Philistines, the former occupying the hinterland and the latter the coasts.

The Hebrews gradually gained the upper hand. From Judea, the first part of Palestine to pass under their control, they spread to Samaria. They crossed the Jordan to the east. The various tribes were ruled by their chiefs with a sort of a loose federation of the whole. About 1050 B. C., Saul, of the tribe of Benjamin, became strong enough to weld the tribes into a nation. He extended the boundaries. David, his successor, completed the work

of unification, bringing all Palestine under one government. During the reins of David and Solomon, who succeeded him, Palestine enjoyed its only existence as the home of a united people under one government.

Solomon divided Palestine into the two kingdoms of Israel and Judea at his death. That was about In 722 Sargon, King of 937 B. C. Assyria, began the subjugation of Israel, a result of which was the carrying away of the ten tribes into captivity. Asshuribanipal completed the conquest seventy-five years later, and all Israel passed under foreign domination. Judea lost its autonomy when Nebuchadnezzar captured Jerusalem in 586. He carried the remaining two tribes to the Babylonian captivity.

In the next half century the Arabs from the south came into Palestine. Darius I incorporated it in Persia when he reorganized that kingdom. It passed to Alexander the Great as a trophy of his war. Ptolemy I annexed it to Egypt when he drove out the Greek conquerors. Antiochus I, of Syria, won it in 197. During the reign of his successor, Antiochus II, the Hebrews were taunted into the Maccabee rebellion, which ended in the freedom of Judea under the rule of princes of the Jewish Church,

The Hebrews, under their own government, became quite influential again, They took Samaria and settled in Galilee. All the ancient territory of Judea east of the Jordan came under their control. Power brought internal dissension and in 65 B. C. Pompey and his Roman legions came. Judea enjoyed nominal independence under Rome's watchful eye. Herod the Great was graciously termed an ally. Six more Herods followed in line, each raised to power by Rome. Their title of king was granted by the Roman senate, and a higher honor was being named honorary praetor. This nominal freedom ended when the Hebrews rebelled in 70 A. D. Rome made Palestine a province.

Palestine was a part of Rome and then of the Byzantine Empire. In 614 Khosru II of Persia asserted his sway over it. His rule was brief, giving way to that of the Moslem, which has remained, with the exception of the short periods that the Crusaders held sway in the Holy Land. [Ex.

Our attention must now be called to a very important preparation, and that is the death of the old man, or self. Sanctification cleanses out the law of sin, or carnal nature, and the old man is nailed to the tree and dies by the daily crucifixion route. Yet the very things that come to us to help kill the old man fail to do so because we fail to show the Christspirit, or to properly die to the self-life.

Between us and Redemption is an experience where we can truly plant both feet and say: "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." (Gal. 2:20.)

It is appointed unto man once to die, and those who expect to meet the Lord must surely die to the "old man," or the self-life.

A final thought: The body must be considered in the preparation. The Bible not only teaches an occasional healing, but a pure, sanctified body, freed from every taint of disease, both inbred and acquired. The exhortation is given: "Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God." (II Cor. 7:1.)

Again, he promises to sanctify our bodies: "And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly: and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." (I Thes. 5:23.)

"For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones." (Eph. 5:30.) "What! Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?" (I Cor. 6:19.)

Paul says: "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service." (Rom. 12:1.)

In the last two verses of Joel, he promises to cleanse our blood: "But Judah shall dwell forever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation. For I will cleanse their blood that I have not cleansed: for the Lord dwelleth in Zion."

What more do we need to give us faith for pure bodies?

It is my profound conviction, after years of careful study and sixteen years in a sanctified body, my blood being cleansed from inbred and acquired germs of disease, the principle of death gone from my body, that it will require this experience to be enabled to put on Redemption. An Open Letter To The Rulers of Europe.

To His Majesty:-

May I beg pardon for this seeming impudent intrusion?

Of olden times it was profitable for Nebuchadnezzar to listen to the servant of the Lord. Although thou art oft beset with cranks, I beg a few moments time to present a message from the King of Kings; not as a crank, but as God's messenger, lest in the coming European conflict, listening to mercenary Statesmen and overzealous Patriots, thou dost allow conditions to arise creating unnecessary and sanguinary results.

This know, O King: The Gentile Age is closing; the restoration and rehabitation of Palestine by Jewry is at hand. The nations covering the Roman Empire's territory must resolve themselves into the TEN TOED KING-DOM closing the vision of Daniel's Image. The fall and dismemberment of the Turkish Empire is at hand, for her "treading down of the Holy Land till the fulfilling of the times of the Gentiles" is ending.
