From the Pastor's Pen



We have selected the theme "REACH UP --- REACH OUT" as our theme for the upcoming primary ministry year, from September 2018 thru June of 2019.

We will be challenging each individual and every ministry team to consider ways that we may REACH UP towards the heavens ... to REACH UP to GOD --- seeking to know Him more and to experience the fullness of His Presence, Peace, and Power in a more vital way.

God promises that He will meet all those who seek Him ... let us REACH HIGH towards God so that we might grow in Him and thru Him.

We'll also be challenging one another to consider ways that we as a church, and we as individuals may better REACH OUT to serve and to help. How we might become a 'LIGHT ON A HILL' for the sake of others ... so that "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven..."

John Wesley delivered a sermon in 1746 in which he described many of the "normal ways" that God's love and grace flows into our lives and our church. He basically categorized them under 2 headings --- 1) WORKS OF PIETY and 2) WORKS OF SERVICE.

We will consider these MEANS OF GRACE. We will identify some of the MEANS (or channels) under each heading SO THAT we might put them to practice in our lives as we all seek to know and experience the love of God in a more real and significant way.

But, also, I want to point out that it is important that we do not focus on either WORKS OF PIETY or WORKS OF SERVICE without, over time asserting them both with equal priority. One without the other leads to a life that is essentially dead and NOT ABLE to fully experience the fullness of Christ that God intends for each of us.

WE NEED TO DRAW FROM BOTH with a good and open heart that truly desires to know and experience God fully --- not only that we may live life more abundantly, but that we might serve the world in a way that is WIN-SOME and RELEVANT to a world that needs the life-giving person of Jesus Christ.




