



Notice of San Luis Obispo LAFCO Protest Hearing

DISSOLUTION OF CAYUCOS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND ACTIVATION OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY POWER - COUNTY SERVICE AREA 10 - LAFCO FILE # 2-R-17

General Information. San Luis Obispo LAFCO approved this action on July 19, 2018. The protest period is open from August 22 to September 24, 2018. Only registered voters and/or property owners within the districts boundaries may submit protests. A Protest Hearing will be held on September 24, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 1055 Monterey Street, County Government Center, San Luis Obispo, CA. **The protest form must be used and can be found on the LAFCO Website at www.slolafo.com or call us at 805.781.5795.** It is not necessary to attend the hearing; protest forms may be submitted or withdrawn prior to the conclusion of the September 24th hearing. The form can be mailed to or dropped off at the LAFCO Office, 1042 Pacific Street, Suite A, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401. The form must be filled out completely with an original signature or it will not be considered a valid written protest. The form cannot be scanned and emailed. If you are in favor of the dissolution do not submit a protest.

Proposal Description/Reasons for Action. The Cayucos Fire Protection District (CFPD) submitted an application to dissolve the District due to limited revenues and increasing costs. Since 2015 the District has discussed dissolution due to rising operational costs, increased training requirements, a lack of available local volunteer staff, need for facility upgrades and equipment replacement. On March 13, 2018 the County Board of Supervisors decided that the County Fire/CAL FIRE would provide fire and emergency response services if the District is dissolved. In order to track revenues transferred from the District, the fire/emergency response authority for CSA 10-Cayucos has been activated. The County will pay for any additional costs of service. Resolution of the Protest Hearing. The Executive Officer determines the validity and number of written protests. The registered voter protest forms are submitted to the Clerks Office for verification. The landowner protest forms are submitted to the County Assessor's Office for verification. The Commission considers the final results.
