Yorkton Canoe & Kayak Club ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

All athletes are to read and sign the following code of conduct. Athletes under the age of 18 must have it signed by a parent or guardian. No athlete will be allowed to participate in any activity, which is subsidized by the Provincial Body, until it is signed and returned.

- 1. The athlete shall adhere to the instructions, rules, curfews, etc., as issued by the coaches, YCKC executive, and/or chaperones during practice, camps, tours, trials, and competitions.
- 2. The athlete shall recognize that the chaperone(s) is/are acting as a replacement guardian while at an event, and therefore will treat the chaperone(s) with respect, adhering to instructions, etc.
- 3. The athlete shall conduct herself/himself as a representative of the sport of canoeing and kayaking and of YCKC in a manner that is exemplary. The athlete shall at all times exercise self-control and show respect for peers, competitors, officials, and spectators.
- 4. The athlete shall not consume or be in possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, or any form of contraband while participating in any YCKC or provincially sponsored activity.
- 5. Any athlete failing to abide by any of the above instructions may be subject penalty and/or removal from programs and/or suspension of membership.
