When the disciples heard this, they fell facedown to the ground, terrified. But Jesus came and touched them. "Get up," he said. "Don't be afraid." When they looked up, they saw no one except Jesus.

Matthew 17:5-8


For such a short passage, these verses are packed with meaning. They give us a profound window not only into why Jesus came in human form, but also speak to our experience as disciples in this life. These verses are part of the larger Transfiguration narrative. Jesus takes a few of his disciples away from the crowds and up on to a mountaintop -- a place that more than once has symbolized a space for meeting God. The Father does not disappoint, first sending Moses and Elijah to greet Jesus and then the spectacular display described above. Many of us understand the importance of Jesus sacrificial work on the cross. To die so that we might live. However, on full display here is another reason for

Christ that we may sometimes overlook -- human beings are downright terrified when they get the smallest taste of the glory of God. Throughout scripture, the most common response to an encounter with God or an angelic messenger of God, is terror. There is something about the amazing otherness of God that causes the sinful human being fear and trembling. The arc of the journey for the disciples go from following Jesus, to confusion, then terror, and finally back to following Jesus. Had it not been for Jesus' reassurance, I'm not sure Peter and the other disciples would have taken their faces out of the dirt. It is Jesus, God in human flesh that is able to come to them, touch them, tell them not to be afraid in a way that they actually seem to be reassured. You can't miss the tenderness of God in the actions of Jesus here, actions that are made possible because he took on human flesh. It is through the common bridge of humanity that God connects with us in ways that were not possible otherwise.

I've always been struck by the words in verse 8: "When they looked up they saw only Jesus." How many times have we hid ourselves out of fear to the call of God, or to the threats of this life, only to eventually find it is Jesus who is pursuing us? Perhaps at this very moment you are in a time of life that is fearful. In my own life I have found again and again, that the way forward out of the fear starts with singular focus on Christ. It is in Christ alone that our fears can be put to rest. Fear will inevitably visit us. The trick is not in avoiding fear all together, but rather to learn to raise our heads and see only Jesus.



DCC has reserved Lake Beauty Bible Camp for the weekend of July 31 - August 2. Cabins and campgrounds are available for rent. Cabins hold up to 14 people and campsites have full hook-ups. Our weekend at camp includes 4 meals (Saturday breakfast, lunch, supper and Sunday breakfast), 2 nights lodging, and meeting room to use. Rates per person are:

Campground: \$75.00

Youth (K-8th grade) Cabin: \$51.00

Activities that can be added for additional cost include Horse Trail Rides, Climbing tower & zip line, High Ropes Activities, Archery Tag, Pontoon Rental. Other activities like Gaga Ball, 9 Square, Disc Golf, Carpet Ball, Volleyball or Basketball are available at no additional cost.

The swimming beach will be open as long as parents are present and take responsibility for their own children.

We are also permitted to bring a boat, fishing gear and games. Each cabin and campsite has a fire pit. No pets allowed in cabins.
