The Cowboy States Reining Horse Association officers and board of directors met via teleconference on Wednesday, **February 13, 2019**. Following the review of our meeting minutes from the January 9 meeting and current treasurer's report, we moved on to business. After some discussion on the vacant Board of Director and Vice Presidential positions, Renee Pipinich agreed to volunteer for the CSRHA Vice-Presidential position. President George Pfeiffer will appoint Justin Henderson and Chantel Probert (both of whom were nominees on the last election ballot) if they agree to serve. Future CSRHA teleconferences now be held on Tuesdays rather than Wednesdays.

Entry fees for the Ranch Riding classes were discussed. These classes have become extremely popular with a wide range of equestrians, but take a considerable amount of time at the shows. Entry fees for the CSRHA Ladies and Gents classes were also discussed. Effective January 2019, there will be a 5-minute time limit in these classes, which are typically used for schooling horses. Once again, neighboring affiliates have set these entry fees at \$40. The CSRHA Ladies and Gents classes will be set at \$30 with no pay back or judge's fees for 2019. Daily prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be awarded along with a year-end award.

The show committee is finding it challenging to find a clinician for the 2-day clinic in April. There was some discussion about other options to include a Ranch Riding clinic, a NRHA judging clinic, or a 'Ride a Reiner' event. Various options for a clinician and/or a judge were discussed. Tammy Scott will be our announcer at the CSRHA Fun Day on April 27. The banquet invitation, 2019 membership form, and signup for the Sam Schaffhauser clinic were mailed the week of February 11.

Planning for the Grasslands Market Slide is on track. Debbie and Bill Russell are working on ordering shavings at a good price for the event which will be the weekend of May 11-12 in Douglas, Wyoming. Chuck Nesmith and Shawn McClurg will be the event judges with Cathy McClurg being the show secretary. The club will be doing some additional advertising this year to inform more people about this fun event.

The CSRHA year-end trophy saddle will most likely be purchased from either Kyle Tack or Silver Spurs this year. Prices have increased on these gorgeous pieces, so sponsorships are certainly going to be requested and appreciated. A \$100 donation will give our sponsors a FULL page colored ad in the CSRHA Membership Directory.
